Online Audition Requirements

The Dance Department is welcoming middle school students who have a passion for dance, and are committed to focused dance training in Ballet and Modern at SDSCPA. Prior and/or current dance training in Ballet and Modern is not required to be accepted into the SDSCPA Dance Program.

To apply to the SDSCPA Middle School Dance program:

Please complete an audition video of no more than 5 minutes in length. Your audition video should be recent (within one month of submission) and must include the following components. Submit the link to your audition video in your audition application.

- Your video should be uploaded into a Google or DropBox folder
- Submit the link to the video file in your audition application.
- The video file must have sharing permissions changed so that anyone with the link can view.

Tips for Preparing your Audition Video

- We need to be able to see you clearly in your video.
- Make sure that your camera is positioned and the lighting allows us to see you.
- Please wear form-fitted athletic or dance attire.
- Please secure hair off your face and neck, so that we can see your movement and you can move safely.

Please include the following components in your video:

1. Introduction. Please introduce yourself by answering the following questions:
 - What is your first and last name?
 - What is your age?
 - What grade will you be entering in the Fall?
 - Why do you want to be a part of the SDSCPA Dance Major program?
2. Perform a dance solo
 - Prepare and perform a solo in any dance style that demonstrates and highlights your passion for dance. Your solo can be your own choreography or someone else's, and should be approximately 30 seconds - 45 seconds in length. Choose music that is appropriate for a school setting. (A list of composers has been provided if you need guidance in finding the right music for your solo.)

We are looking for students that show us the following traits:

- Effort and potential for growth
- Engagement, collaboration, and respect for the learning environment
- Strong work ethic and commitment
- Genuine interest and enthusiasm
