PAC report

SIP (School Improvement Plan) focuses on:

❖ Literacy/Math -

- **Student Outcome Goal** - By the end of the school year, 75% of K-8 students will meet their "[Stretch Growth Goal](#)" on the iReady Benchmark in the subject area of **Reading**.
- **Student Outcome Goal** - By the end of the school year, 75% of K-8 students will meet their "[Stretch Growth Goal](#)" on the iReady Benchmark in the subject area of **Math**.
- **Educator Practice Goal** - By end of Cycle 1, each collaborative team will craft and regularly reflect on their collective commitments during scheduled meetings as evidenced by PLC logs/notes.
- **Action Steps** -
 - Establish staff teams and collective commitments to the process through presented as not an add on, but something to get us to our results by making it cohesive and streamlined.
 - Providing clarification on how teams operate.
 - Making collaboration a priority.
 - Create Co Teaching/PLC calendar and agenda to meet twice a month.

❖ Attendance/Behavior

- **Student Outcome Goal Attendance-(94.3%)** By the end of Cycle 1, maintain attendance rates above 95% for all students, as measured by attendance rate as compared to month-over-month data.
- **Student Outcome Goal Behavior** - By the end of cycle 1, we will reduce the number of behavior referrals by 2 for all students, as measured by discipline referral number as compared to month-over-month data.
- **Educator Practice Goal** - By the end of cycle 1, co-created expectations and procedures will have been taught and reviewed with students as evidenced by posted matrices in all classrooms and student spaces.
- **Action Steps** -
 - Expectations posted in all classrooms
 - Time spent first week of school co-creating expectations with students
 - Schedule for teaching and practicing expectations and procedures to all students
 - Attendance as a responsible behavior embedded within expectations
 - Information shared with families around the importance of attendance and procedures to excuse student when sick

- ❖ **Assessments:** iReady for Gr.1 – 5 Math and Reading; AimsWeb K4-3rd grade - reading screener; CogAt for Gr. 2; CR assessments – research, discussions, projects, problem-solving, quizzes – ongoing Formative Assessments that inform instruction; Wisconsin Forward Assessment for Gr. 3-5 in all subjects (Summative Assessment) – informs instruction. NAEP this year

- ❖ **School Climate/Culture:** behavior expectations– Responsible, Respectful, and Safe; school wide discipline - positive reinforcement with teaching, enforcing and reinforcing HC's school

wide expectation; restorative practices, implementing mindful practices, scheduling wellness breaks

❖ Attendance – 94.3%.
