7:17 – 7:27 16th Ave Storm Interceptor & 17th Ave Closure Update – Matt Farris

- All new infrastructure is in up to tunneling process
- Week of 1/18 the team will start digging a pit for tunnel equipment under 17th Ave. Work will continue to Albion Street. Timeframe is 15 days including Saturdays.
- Once to Albion Street, sanitation work will take place. Then the team will jump back to 17th Ave to connect to the sanitary system.
- Inlets at 17th Ave & Colorado Blvd will be installed following work noted above.
- Bike Path work commencing in 1-2 weeks. Bike path will enter from Colorado & 17th Ave into the park.
- Colorado Blvd Closure- Saturday, January 22nd for relocation of fiber optic line- elevate it 5ft

Q: When will 17th Street reopen?

A: Late March

7:28 – 7:49 Garfield St Neighborhood Bikeway - Jacob Hurley & John La Sala

- Underground electrical work, utility work is in motion
- Concrete work scheduled for February
- Timeline – Scheduled thru late March
- Street Parking will remain on Garfield
- No left turn onto 17th Ave from Garfield St.

Questions from the community:

Q: What is a full closure of 17th Ave. vs what is existing?

A: No changes, existing closure to remain.

Q: Will there be a physically protective bike lane?

A: No, it will be share the road (neighborhood bike way).

Q: How far west of Colorado will be repaved?

A: Jackson St. to Colorado Blvd in current scope of work. North Josephine intersection to Colorado Blvd. scheduled for 2022 by Street Maintenance, TBD on exact timing. Street Maintenance details can be found [HERE](#)

Q: Is there a concern about limiting the left turn from Garfield?

A: It will be safer for pedestrians and bicyclists

Q: What does the intersection and connection into the park bike lane look like?

A: Bike path & pedestrian walkway.

Q: Where will the median be located?

A: Median will only be at the Garfield intersection.

Q: Will there be a curb cut on the North side of 17th to enter the park from Garfield?

A: Yes.

Q: Will there be any above ground structures at Garfield St?

A: Manhole on the west side of Colorado Blvd.

Q: Will there be a light at 17th & Garfield? Will it be timed, or will it require someone to indicate they are present and need to cross?

A: There will be a traffic light, bike signal (actual bike icon) & pedestrian signal. The traffic signal will have push buttons for pedestrians. Cyclists & motor vehicles will be detected when they are located where the detection is active. Paint will identify the location where a cyclist needs to stand.

7:49 – 7:57 Nature Play Area in City Park - Jacqueline Altreuter

- Denver Museum of Nature & Science and Denver Parks & Recreation have partnered to bring a Natural Play Experience to City Park! Thanks to the City Park master plan that was completed in 2018.
- Nearby Nature Initiative seeks to amplify the museum's activity to the nearby nature that already exists at City Park. Community feedback over the last couple of years has shown demand for a water way and natural play experiences.
- Based on this feedback a biofiltration wet land will be installed that will naturally clean the water that will be recirculated thru the historic water way. The historic water way is also in the process of being repaired as part of this project. The work will take place near the new bike lane and continue to the small pond.
- The project is in 50% detailed design. 100% detail design to be presented soon for late 2022/ early 2023 install.

Q: Are there any updates on plant selection?

A: City Park Horticulture, Denver Botanic Gardens, Denver Parks & Recreation and Colorado Plant Society have been working together in selecting plants that are representative to the park and the ecosystem.
