


### nPb or PbPb

- Sindow Piebald is not to be confused with other species piebald and the
  overall general term being used for white patches over the fur. Sindow
  Piebald has a certain look, very much similar to what is found in deer.
  It is speckled and spotted.
- It should not be confused with other types of white marking and leopard complex especially. It can look very similar and sometimes the only way to tell is to look at the pheno.
- Piebald can show on the wings as well. There's not a strict min/max or specific rules for Piebald on the wings, so as long as it follows the overall rules it'll be fine.

This first example is pretty minimal. At its most minimum it can show only the paws, only the belly, etc...






## **Maximum Piebald:**

- It may look similar to fewspot, but generally the spots are larger.




