Tournament Game Day Ops Checklist (League Responsibilities)

Host League

Pre/Post Game Ops (2-3 volunteers)

- Local Media (optional) 24 hr prior to game
- Pre-Game Field Care/Field Prep
 - Pre-game Field mowed, prepped, lined, and Anywhere between 24-2 hrs prior to game
 - Pre-game Field dressed and made game ready 15 min. prior to game
 - Post-game Field closed, covered, and made ready for next game
- Facility is made ready presentable to general public and in working order *Approx 2 hrs prior to game*Bathrooms are clean and well stocked
- Team dugouts and batting cages made ready Approx 2 hrs prior to game
- U.S.flag, MD flag and LL Banners presented Approx 2 hrs prior to game

Game Ops (3-5 volunteers)

- Provide game balls (RST) Have enough ready and available for Umpires
- Game Host/General Contact (Recommended) Arrive 2hr before game
 - Supporting/Organizing Team/Coaches
 - Supporting District Staff/Umpires
 - Supporting Pressbox Ops
- Be Safety Ready (consider the "What if...weather, medical etc.")
 - Assess Heat Conditions for Players/Fans/Umpires
 - Consider Providing misters/shade/fans/cool cloths
- Pressbox volunteers (Recommended) Arrive 30-60 min. before game
 - Official Scorekeeper
 - Announcer and music (including National Anthem)
 - Scoreboard Operator
 - Official Pitch Counter

Concessions Ops (3-5 volunteers)

- Open at least 1 hr before game time
- Consider making Special Tournament Menu
- Dugout water coolers filled and delivered minimum 1 hr before game time
- Provide Umpire refreshments
- Provide courtesy post-game hot dog(or alternative) and drink for all players/coaches/umpires (Be prepared for shortened games)
- Consider fundraising (ie 50/50 and tip jars)

Guest League

- Be respectful of the host league and tournament officials
 - Be on-time (understanding of pre-game tournament ops)
 - Be accepting of league hospitality (be sure to take post-game food)
 - Clean-up after yourself (batting cages, dugouts, bleachers)
