Leonard R. Lange Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. Leonard Lange, 590 High street, left today for his re-entry into active naval service. He is to report to Norfolk, Va., by next Wednesday.

Lange, who is being recalled as a lieutenant junior grade, served as an ensign in the Hawaiian islands port director's office in World war II. He was in World war II service from 1943 to 1945.

The 25-year-old navy man was commissioned a lieutenant junior grade last year. He is unmarried.

Ens. Leonard D. Lange, 590 High street, won the victory medal, American area service ribbon and the Asiatic-Pacific area service ribbon. He entered service April 22, 1943.
