Tone Range (up one whole tone)

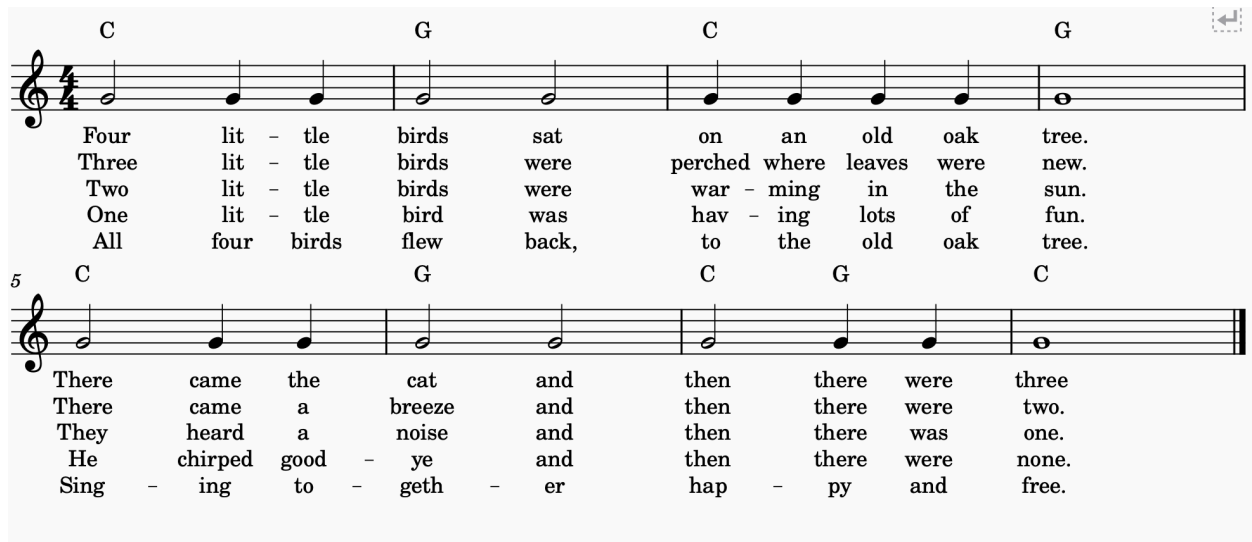


## Chords Learned

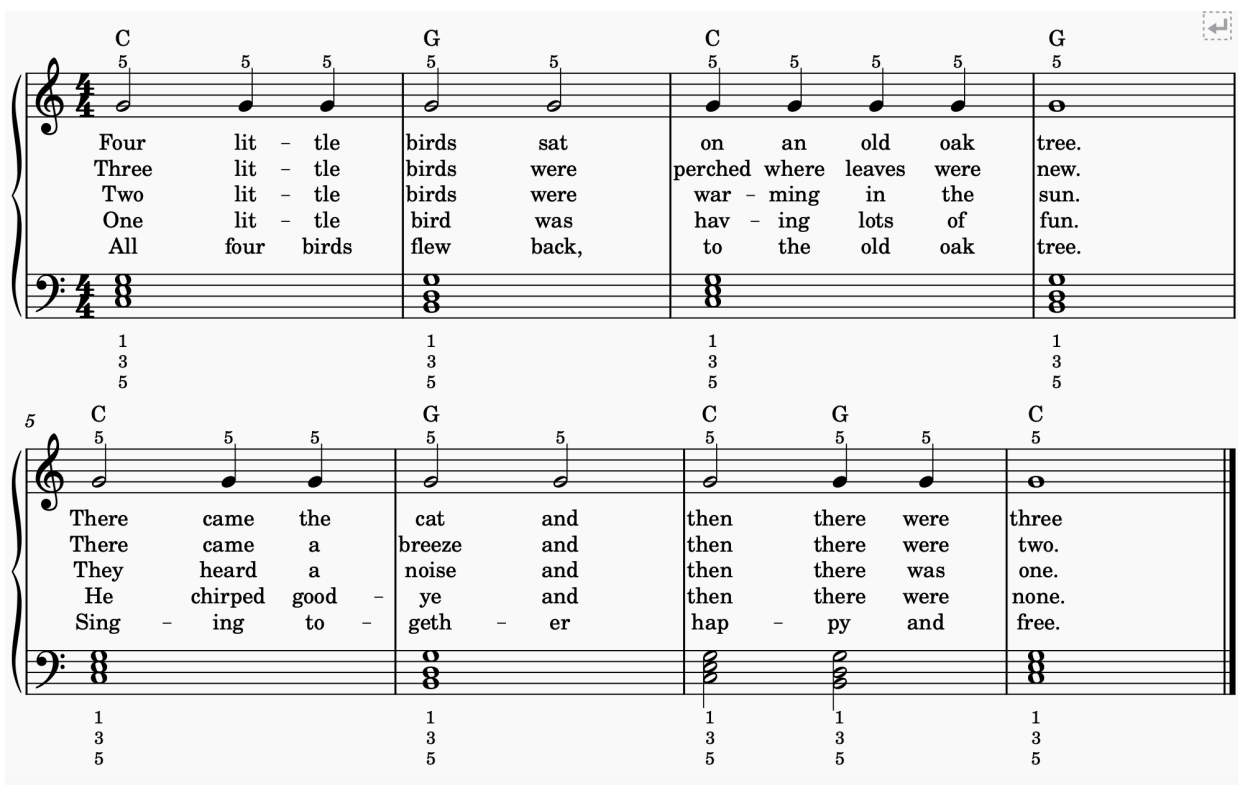

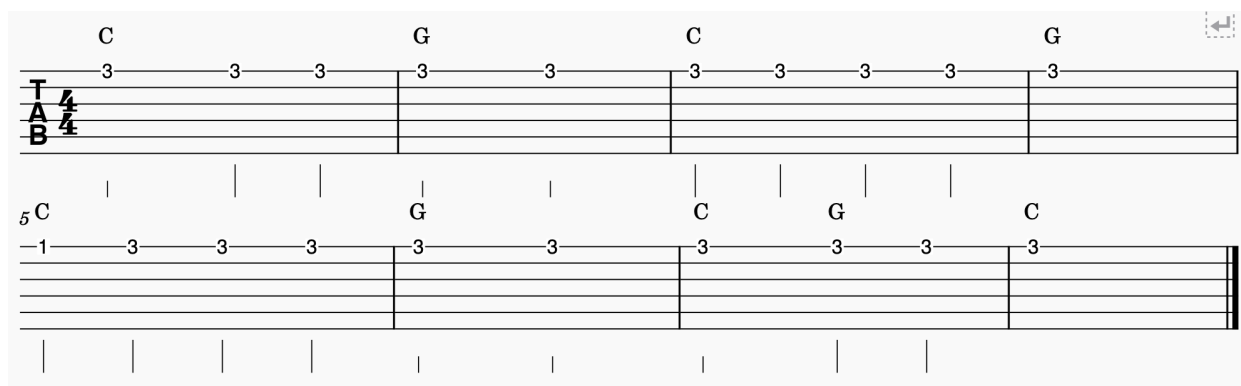

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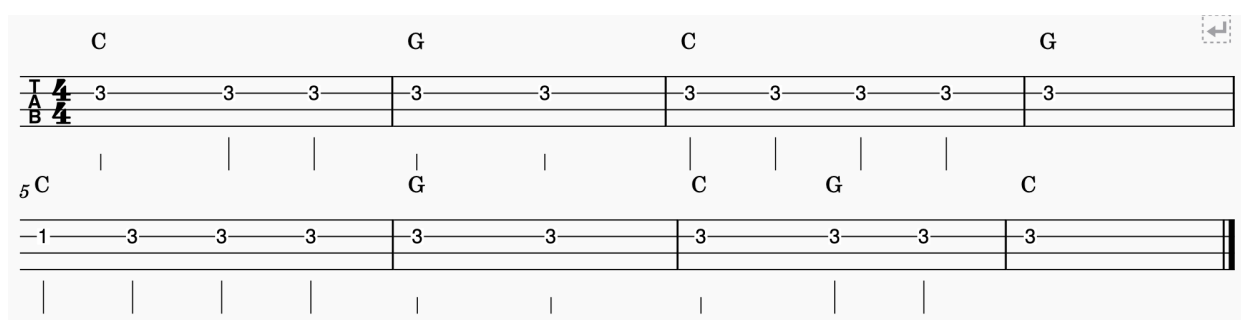

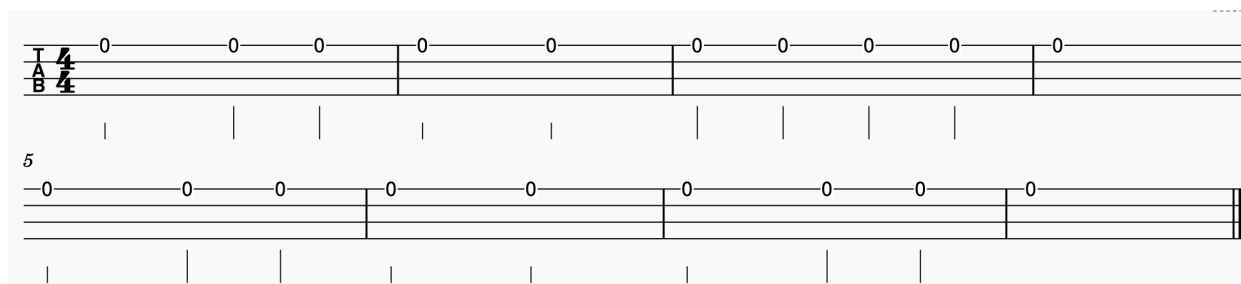
