Group Instrument Classes in Canton Elementary Schools:

GRADE 5: Students in grade 5 can choose between band (flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone), strings (violin, viola, cello, bass), or chorus. Classes are free of charge, and **are taught during the school day**. Students registered in the spring. If your student is new to Canton, please email eckersleyc@cantonma.org to register.

GRADE 4: Students in grade 4 have general music during the school day. In addition they can choose to be in strings class (violin, viola, cello, bass). Strings classes are free of charge but happen before the school day according to the schedule below. Here is the <u>fourth grade registration link.</u> You will need to arrange transportation to school the morning of your child's class. Strings Class will begin September 16th.
