

# SPN Prompt Bang

## Rules & FAQ

- Each prompt is allowed (1) one claim each from an artist and an author. It is up to both the artist and author to decide if they'd like to collaborate on their fills for the bang.
- Any prompt is open to *any* ship or gen fic/art.
  - ◆ This may lead to the following situation: a prompt having two different ships. We are completely open to this scenario!
- We will not tolerate hate of any form from any participant. If you see a fic or a piece of art that you do not like, just move past it. We are a 'SUPERNATURAL' bang, and because of such want to open this idea to everyone, and not just a specific group.
- We ask that you maintain the SCHEDULE to the best of your ability.
  - ◆ We also understand that some things happen to prevent that, and request you send us a note, if you need an extension.

### ARTIST REQUIREMENTS

Two pieces of new art that fit the prompt. (No smaller than 300x300)

### AUTHOR REQUIREMENTS

One 10k story that fits the prompt.

- Again, all ships, all ratings, all genres... all of it is allowed. As long as your story or art is a vague interpretation of the prompt, you will be successfully participating.
  - We ask that all submissions (art and fic) are properly tagged throughout the process to keep everyone happy.
  - If we have a disproportionate amount of authors to artists, we may allow artists to choose two prompts. This will be at the moderator's discretion and announced after sign-ups end.
  - (more rules may be added as needed)

### **Why should I (an author) go to all of this effort if I'm not going to get art like a traditional bang?**

We totally understand this concern, and want to stress that working with your prompt partner is completely up to the two of you. However, we are here less to make sure each fic gets a piece of art, and more to make sure the fandom as a whole is introducing new art and fic.

You must remember that a few awesome things happen when you participate in a bang: 1) you get an influx of new readers that maybe haven't seen your stuff before; and 2) you are following through on a deadline and getting a story completed!

### **How will claims work?**

We are going to allow until the end of August for as many people to sign up for the challenge as possible. At that point, we will release a list of 'prompts' — this list will be compiled of both A/U options and Canon — and a claims form for you to fill out and submit on the given date. Prompts will be assigned first come/first serve, and we will only have as many available as we have participants (just to make things a bit more interesting). Because we cannot guarantee that we will have equal author/artist numbers, some prompts may only have one claim.

### **How will posting work?**

We are big fans of allowing posting to stretch over a period of time. So when that fun time comes, all authors will get a two weeks stretch in which they can post their chapters individually instead of all at once.

### **Will there be check-ins?**

Yup! All of that info is on our schedule.

### **Can I talk about my story/art?**

Since we aren't a traditional bang, we allow promos anytime after you have made your prompt claim. However, we do ask that you refrain from posting any part of your art or story until your assigned posting date!

### **Is RPF allowed?**

Sure! The only restriction we have is we won't allow anything with underage real persons or the actors' children.

### **Can I sign up as both an artist and an author?**

Yes. Sure. Why not? But if you commit to that, you have to follow through. Hell, if you want to try and claim the same prompt as both parties, go for it!
