Now that you have learned what your Joined Nations country is, you will be required to research your country and make an informative slideshow presentation of at least 10 slides **and** present it to the class. Most of the information you will need can be found in the CIA World Factbook at https://goo.gl/vpjtDE, BBC's country profiles page at http://goo.gl/7x8deo, or Nations Online at http://goo.gl/sDHifw. However, you may find that you will need to do some extra searching.

Follow the requirements and structure below to complete your slideshow. Remember you need at least 10 slides for full points.

Slide 1: Title Page

• Flag and official name of your country

Slide 2: Introduction

- A brief introduction to your country.
- Include a few unique or surprising facts about your country

Slides 3-4: Geography

- Land and location
 - Include a map of your country
 - o Information about your country's land, geography, and climate
- Introduce some natural and manmade landmarks in your country

Slides 5-6: Culture

- Introduce important aspects of your country's culture. Examples of information to include...
 - o Most important values, beliefs, and traditions of your country
 - Major religions in your country
 - Languages spoken in your country
 - Interesting customs or practices
 - Traditional foods

Slide 7: Economy

- Introduce your country's economy. Include information about...
 - How big is your country's economy (GDP)?
 - O How rich is your country (GDP per capita)?
 - What are the most common jobs in your country?
 - Pictures of life in your country

Slides 8-10: Politics

- What kind of government does your country have?
 - Who has the power? Who are the leaders?



- How free is your country? (goo.gl/b6eNsB)
 - How is your country's system of government and level of freedom related?
- What is your country's relationship with the rest of the world?
 - Who are your country's friends?
 - o Is your country at war?

Your slideshow total points: 50 RP
