Psalm 150 - The Crescendo at the End of the "Halleluia Psalms" [145-150]

Psalm 150:1-6 Praise the LORD! Praise God in His sanctuary; Praise Him in His mighty expanse. 2 Praise Him for His mighty deeds; Praise Him according to His excellent greatness.

- 3 <u>Praise Him with trumpet sound; Praise Him with harp and lyre.</u> 4 <u>Praise Him with timbrel and dancing; Praise Him with stringed instruments and pipe.</u> 5 <u>Praise Him with loud cymbals; Praise Him with resounding cymbals.</u>
- 6 Let everything that has breath praise the LORD. Praise the LORD!

Worship with Music

<u>Psalm 150, The Psalms are Filled with Instructions – Even Commands to Worship God with Music, both Instrumental and with Words</u>

Worshipful Dancing

Psalms 150:4 " Praise Him with timbrel and dancing"

Clapping & Shouting

Psalms 47:1 For the choir director. A Psalm of the sons of Korah. O <u>clap your hands, all peoples; Shout to God with the voice of joy.</u>

Psalms 98:4- "Shout joyfully to the LORD, all the earth; Break forth and sing for joy and sing praises

<u>Looking UP</u> - John 17:1 Jesus spoke these things; and lifting up His eyes to heaven, He said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son, that the Son may glorify You,"

Praise for What He has Done

This Psalm Goes a Long Way to Say, Everybody and Everything Should Praise the Lord

Psalms 148:5 & 13 Let them praise the name of the LORD, For He commanded and they were created. ... 13 Let them praise the name of the LORD, For His name alone is exalted; His glory is above earth and heaven. 14 And He has lifted up a horn for His people, Praise for all His godly ones; Even for the sons of Israel, a people near to Him. Praise the LORD!

• Praise is Declaring the Goodness, Power, Righteousness etc – Of What God has Done

Singing God's Praises to the Young – The Next Generation

Psalms 145:4 One generation shall praise Your works to another, And shall declare Your mighty acts.

Psalms 78:4-8 We will not conceal them from their children, But tell to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, And His strength and His wondrous works that He has done. 5 For He established a testimony in Jacob And appointed a law in Israel, Which He commanded our fathers That they should teach them to their children, 6 That the generation to come might know, even the children yet to be born, That they may arise and tell them to their children, 7 That they should put their confidence in God And not forget the works of God, But keep His commandments, :8 And not be like their fathers, A stubborn and rebellious generation, A generation that did not prepare its heart And whose spirit was not faithful to God.

Giving Thanks

Psalms 92:1-5 A Psalm, a Song for the Sabbath day. It is good to give thanks to the LORD And to sing praises to Your name, O Most High; 2 To declare Your lovingkindness in the morning And Your faithfulness by night, 3 With the ten-stringed lute and with the harp, With resounding music upon the lyre. 4 For You, O LORD, have made me glad by what You have done, I will sing for joy at the works of Your hands. 5 How great are Your works, O LORD! Your thoughts are very deep.

1 Thessalonians 5:16 -19 Rejoice always; 17 pray without ceasing; **18** in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. 19 **Do not quench the Spirit**;

Raising Hands

To Bless

Luke 24:49-50 "And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high." 50 And He led them out as far as Bethany, and <u>He lifted up His hands and blessed them.</u>

To Pray

1 Timothy 2:8 Therefore I want the men in every place to pray, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and dissension.

As a Sign of Humility and Surrender to God

Lamentations 3:40-41 Let us examine and probe our ways, And let us return to the LORD. 41 We lift up our heart and hands Toward God in heaven;

Ezra 9:5-6 But at the evening offering I arose from my humiliation, even with my garment and my robe torn, and I fell on my knees and stretched out my hands to the LORD my God; 6 and I said, "O my God, I am ashamed and embarrassed to lift up my face to You, my God, for our iniquities have risen above our heads and our guilt has grown even to the heavens.
