YouTube Accessibility for the Visually Impaired:

- Dark Mode. Black background with white text.
- Search with Your Voice. Say your search instead of typing one in.
- Use Siri or Google. Search and play a specific video or type of video.

YouTube Dark Mode:

Search YouTube with Your Voice:

Say your search instead of typing one in.

Find the Search with Your Voice button, represented by a microphone symbol, located to the right of the search bar.

Press and release the Search with Your Voice button. You will hear a beep. You can then say your search. When you are done saying your search, press and release the microphone button. You will then hear another beep.

Use YouTube with Siri/Google:

- Pause a video. Hey Siri/Google, pause video.
- Hey Siri/Google, play [song name] by [musician's name] on YouTube.
- For example: Hey Siri/Google, play jazz music on YouTube.
- Hey Siri/Google, search [your search] on YouTube.
- For example: Hey Siri/Google, search Be My Eyes on YouTube.
