

Tenor Music Tutoring Information

Tenor Music is a student-led program operating in the Madison-Middleton area striving to motivate incoming elementary and middle school students from grades 3-8 to enjoy playing their instrument, by assisting the growth of the student's ability as well as that of the whole music program. Each student will be paired with a tutor that they will work continuously with to strengthen their music skills. These tutors will be given 2.5 hours of service learning for every 1-hour lesson they lead. This can be divided up into two parts: 1 hour for the lesson itself and 1.5 hours for the time tutors dedicate to planning and preparing for each lesson.

Tutors are high school musicians who have thorough knowledge and skill of the instrument that they play. While all levels of skill in playing an instrument are to be valued, because Tenor Music requires musicians to give instruction to others, tutors must be at a point in which they are confident enough in their capabilities to assist the growth of younger students in the musical world.

High school musicians interested in tutoring an elementary/middle school student should take the following steps:

1. Fill out the Tenor Music Tutor Application Google Form. Tenor Music will send an email once/if the application is approved.
2. Once the student receives approval to become a tutor, fill out the following documents:

3. Submit the two completed documents above to tenormusicwi@gmail.com.

After being matched with a student, the tutor is provided with the student's contact information and will be responsible to contact the student's parent or guardian to determine a convenient date, time, and location for lessons. An adult must be present at each lesson. Tutors keep track of lessons on the "Lessons Record" form, and submit it at the conclusion of each month to receive payment or volunteer service hours.
