

Ms. Lynch's 4th Grade School Supply List

Essentials

1. Backpack
2. PE Shoes (non-marking please)
3. Reusable Water Bottle (please label with name and wash weekly)
4. Student Planner (speak to office staff)
5. Earbuds (headphones tend to get tangled and broken at school)
6. 2-Inch Binder (one, preferably with clear front sleeve)
7. Pocketed Binder Dividers (1 package of at least 5)
8. 2-4 packs of loose leaf paper (wide rule for 4th graders)
9. Pack of Pre-Sharpened Pencils
10. Colored Pencils
11. 3-5 Fine-Point Dry Erase Markers
(these are closest to pencil-sized and good for handwriting training)
12. 2 Boxes Facial Tissues
13. Package of glue sticks (2 or more)
14. 2 Pocket Folders (1 red, 1 green)
15. 1 package of cap erasers

OPTIONAL ITEMS!

16. Ziploc Bags-(gallon or sandwich-sized)
17. Clorox Wipes (1-2 canisters)
18. 1 pallet of watercolor paints
19. 1 package hot glue sticks
20. Scissors

Additional Items (Admittedly a bit unorthodox)

- Empty Clorox-style Wipe Containers- I'll zip tie them to desk legs to use as water bottle holders to keep the water bottles from rolling all over the floor or crashing to the floor!
- Used dryer sheets- dryer sheets are designed to reduce static cling meaning they remove the dust and prevent it from resettling on Chromebooks
