Script

Hey! Sorry I'm late. I overslept. Thanks for saving me a seat.

[Sighs]

Professor Anderson is nice, but she's so *boring*. If you weren't here, I don't think I'd have it in me to show up at all.

She's still showing examples of past class papers, huh? Those things are *so* dense.

(setting up for a reveal) Must take some *serious* brain power to finish one of them...

Speaking of which----

[Papers rustling]

(self satisfied) *Boom*. My half of the project, and then some. Finished.

...

It's why I overslept! I was up all last night working on it. 15,000 words from this big ol' brain on the contributions and cultural implications of the Phoenicians.

--- Oh. Oops. Spelled Phoenicians wrong.

Eh, Phoenicians, Phoenixans; Potato, tomato. Easy fix! The point is, *now* we can---

...

What? We were... supposed to do our project on the... *Philippines*?

[Laughs]

[Plastic bag rustling]

I bought that brand of gummies that you like! Had to go to like, 5 different stores to find them. Want some while we get some of the beginning parts of the project done?
