WHAT'S HAPPENING: Federal Clean School Bus Funding Is At Risk

Congress is advancing a reconciliation bill that:

- Repeals and rescinds unobligated funds in the EPA Clean Heavy-Duty Vehicle Program
- Repeals and rescinds unobligated funds for DERA (specific to what was allocated in IRA)
- Eliminates tax credits, newly available to school districts via elective ("direct") pay, that offer up to \$40,000 per electric school bus and up to \$100,000 per charging station
 - o 45W Tax Credit for Qualifying Commercial Clean Vehicles
 - o 30C Tax Credit for Alternative Fuel Vehicle Refueling Property

Key Components of a Constituent Letter

- Introduce yourself name, occupation, where you live
- Affirm that you are their constituent either through where you live or where you work
- Describe what you are concerned about -- a pause in federal funding, permanent cuts to federal funding, changes to the program, etc.
- Describe how you have benefitted from the tax credits or funding programs, for example:
 - o FUNDING How much funding your organization/company/school district received
 - NEW BUSES How many clean school buses you have purchased or deployed
 - o KIDS How many students are expected to ride in those clean school buses
 - o COST SAVINGS How much money your fleet is saving on operating expenses
 - AIR QUALITY Any data from your grant or rebate application that highlights other benefits -- reduction in key pollutants, for example
 - OTHER BENEFITS Any special components of your clean school bus project, for example, if you are deploying vehicle-to-grid technology, solar energy, repowered buses, etc.
 - LOCAL JOBS Name any other *local* companies you are working with on this project, including the manufacturer or dealer, contractors, electricians, etc.
- If possible, explain why you applied for funding or are invested in clean school buses -- to save money on purchasing new buses, to address air quality issues near your school, to take advantage of vehicle-to-grid technology, etc.
- Name what you are personally experiencing -- can't access grant funds, not sure if rebate funding will arrive, would like to apply in the future, etc.
- Make your ask (pick one or customize your own):
 - o I ask you to work with Congress to continue this funding so that more students can benefit from cleaner buses and cleaner air.
 - Our community is benefitting from this program. I respectfully urge you to oppose the Congressional bill that would repeal or defund it.
 - We are looking forward to applying for this [program and/or tax credits] and bringing cleaner school buses to our community. Please vote no on eliminating this key funding.
