Volunteer Policy


Parent/Guardian Volunteer Requirement:

- ★ **What's Expected:** Each parent/guardian is asked to volunteer for a minimum of two hours per major tournament (tournaments listed below) for each student-athlete participating in the activity. This commitment applies to all parents/guardians, regardless of their child's playing time or standing on the team.
- ★ **Who Can Help:** If parents/guardians are unable to volunteer, other family members or members of the community can step in to fulfill the volunteer requirement.
- ★ **Responsibility of Student-Athletes:** We encourage student-athletes to reach out to family members, teachers, or community members to help fulfill the volunteer requirement if their parent/guardian is unable to do so. The student-athlete will provide the volunteer with their unique ID number.

How To Record Volunteer Hours:

- ★ **Student-Athlete Number:** Each student-athlete is assigned a unique 3-digit number to use when volunteering. Please use this number to count towards your student-athlete's volunteer hours requirement.
- ★ **Tracking:** When a student-athlete's number is used on the 'Sign-Up' sheet, it is recorded on a separate hidden page. After the student-athlete has 2 hours recorded, extra hours will be added to an 'Hour Bank' that will be applied to other student-athletes.

- ★ **What Happens if Requirements Aren't Met:** Failure to fulfill the volunteer requirements will result in the loss of travel privileges for the next tournament.
- ★ **Important Note:** If there are no upcoming travel events for the sport, the loss of travel privileges will carry over to the next sport season. However, this rule does not apply to regional or state-level travel events.
