Important Notices & Agreements

- **Eligibility:** Students with Class A or B offenses since August 3, 2026, cannot attend.
- **Age Requirements:** Guests must be 13–20 years old and currently in high school.
- **Refunds:** No refunds will be issued for any reason.
- **Ticket Purchasing:** Information will be provided after completion of this form.
- **Conduct:** All school rules apply. Disruptive behavior will result in removal without a refund.
- **Security:** Large bags must be checked. Attendees are subject to searches for illegal substances.
- **Cancellation:** The school may stop the dance for safety or drug issues. No refunds will be given.
- **Tickets:** Tickets are non-transferable and cannot be traded or sold.
- **Identification:** Bring a student or government ID. Guests must arrive with their Kealakehe host.
- **Violations:** Violations may lead to suspension or loss of senior/graduation privileges.
- **Dancing & Attire:** Administrators may deny entry or remove anyone for inappropriate dress or dancing.

Dress Guidelines

Please dress as the gender you identify with. All attendees must follow the following dress guidelines:

- Attire must be semi-formal and follow gender identity.
- Dresses must be no shorter than 2 inches above mid-thigh (including slits).
- Backless permitted to the waist only; no bare midriffs or low-cut tops.
- No sheer fabric, exposed lingerie, or undergarments.
- Shirts must have sleeves and remain on at all times.
- Dress pants or slacks only; jeans and corduroy are prohibited.
- No sunglasses, bandanas, chains, or canes.

Dancing Guidelines

- Dancing must not be lewd or lascivious.
- No grinding, straddling legs, or bending over.
- No inappropriate touching or prolonged public displays of affection.
- Keep hands on waists or shoulders only.
