Take Action for Medicaid Expansion – Toolkit

The goal of this toolkit is to empower individuals and organizations in Florida's fight for Medicaid expansion. These shareable materials are meant to drive supporters to act by contacting their elected representatives while helping to build a grassroots movement.

Key Messages and Ask

- The outbreak of COVID-19 shows why it is important that every hardworking Floridian has the security of health care coverage. 400,000 Floridians can no longer wait, the time to expand Medicaid is now.
- Medicaid expansion can protect Floridians from severe hardship as the economic downturn worsens and bring additional federal dollars into the state at a time its desperately needed.
- Expanding Medicaid would save Florida's budget an estimated \$200 million annually.
- Ask: Florida lawmakers should call a special session and pass Medicaid expansion to manage the impact of COVID-19.
