Board meetings are meetings held in public but not public meetings. This means that the Board may call upon students, staff, and members of the public to speak at its discretion. The Board will also allow anyone who has requested and received approval to be placed on the board’s agenda today to speak. If you have questions about the process for being placed on the board’s agenda, you may discuss this with the board president or superintendent after the meeting.”**

 - i. This forum will provide an opportunity to discuss how North Dakota's school funding system is affected by enrollment changes and the challenges school districts face as fixed costs continue to rise. The conversation will focus on the impact these issues have on Rugby Public School District and provide an opportunity for attendees to ask questions and gain a better understanding of the financial realities facing our local schools.
