Mission / Vision / Focus for 2025–26

Principal’s Report – Marlo Franks

Marlo provided a detailed update on the school’s consolidation, renovation, and transition planning. The school year is off to a strong start, and staff are optimistic about the enhancements coming to the building and community.

Discussion Points

- Construction & Renovation Plans: Major remodels, new classrooms, improved security entryways, refreshed staff spaces, and playground upgrades.
- Enrollment & Capacity: Combined enrollment projected at ~516 students; four classrooms per grade ensuring smaller class sizes.

- Curriculum & Academic Highlights: Continued success of Think SRSD writing program and UFLY phonics expansion.
- Rebranding & School Identity: New name, mascot, colors, and logo expected by Jan 2026; 'Crew' values to remain.
- Community Engagement: Collaboration between SVE and Heritage PTAs to unify events and traditions.
- Safety & Traffic: Security and infrastructure improvements underway, supported by mill/bond funding.

Teacher Update – Christy Wohlleber

Christy shared brief classroom highlights and confirmed she will provide full grade-level updates at the next meeting.
