Mr. Thongchai, Parent Association President, will meet with me soon, and we will discuss parents' important involvement in the WASC process. Thank you, Mr. Thongchai.

One of the great things about TCIS is that we are a WASC accredited school. There are several major advantages to having your child attend a WASC accredited school. Among the many advantages are:

- Having an outside and unbiased agency assesses the quality of our programs
- There is a requirement for the school admin to regularly reflect upon all areas of the school and plan for improvement
- Accreditation requires certain quality and certification standards for all teaching staff be met.
- There is a requirement for community involvement in the school
- Students receive diplomas that are accepted world-wide with the same standing as a diploma from schools located in the USA.

We are currently drafting the TCIS 2021 Self-Study, and it will be sent to WASC towards the end of February. Our admin team and staff have put a lot of effort into preparing the report. It was truly a community effort. The WASC team will conduct a four-day virtual visit in April, and our campus will be very well prepared for a successful visit.
