These events will be held at various family-friendly locations such as Rhode Island state parks, the Providence Children's Museum, and the Roger Williams Park Zoo. Meal benefit applications are sent to RI households during the summer alongside a letter informing families of the free and reduced-price meal program. Information provided by families is confidential and only used to determine benefits students will receive. 
Arrival and Dismissal
