Minutes:

1. Meeting called to order at 4:05 pm
2. Ice breaker – Favorite fall activity
3. Butterfly garden plan changing – strategy is to do a different plan with funds from PTA if available. Teacher Action Team – more teachers with representation from each grade level. Still will be student led, pacing will be changed to slow down and accommodate teacher schedule. Blair applied for two grants from Bright Green Futures to get an automated watering system and automated irrigation and features for the butterfly garden. Decision in November and funding in November.
4. Principal report from Jessica –CAC provides avenue for input by parents/interested parties at local school. CAC approves campus budget (\$ and staff allocation) and reviews the Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR). Provides input into the Campus Improvement Plan (CIP) and professional

development (PD) plan. Boundary change proposal update – because Bryker Woods is proposed to close, there will be ~70 students newly zoned to BW school if this is voted in by the AISD Board on Nov 20th. There is a requirement for community engagement so the proposal went out prior to voting so community can provide opinion. For Brentwood, no boundaries are being removed only expanded. There is concern about the cafeteria capacity if the school population is expanded. Students will continue to feed into Lamar and McCallum, except for transfers which may not be able to attend the Brentwood/Lamar/McCallum vertical.

- a. Question: what additional resources will BW get? Principal Hosack answers that we will get resources according to the district formulas which are according to student number. If the students have special needs that need specific support staff will also be provided.
 - b. Question: Is there a community outreach meeting scheduled? Waiting until the board votes on this change to communicate. There may be adjustments based on the community input.
5. GT vs Enrichment: GT is parent-led, AISD does not provide GT pull-out for students. Enrichment is extra opportunities provided to all students. GT is available to students who are identified by AISD testing, the teacher will modify the lessons using district-provided materials/lesson plans. GT services only provided 2nd-5th grades.
6. Ms. Thompson shared that Abby Jones (prev Brentwood Teacher) volunteered to be the CAC community member and will likely attend virtually most of the time.
7. PTA report being postponed until next meeting due to running over on time.
