6-7 grade currently has:

Opened 23-24 school year

Year 2 will be 24-25 school year:

6-7-8 grades

Estimates: 720 students, 100 staff, 3 lunches (will be by grade), who knows how many buses

Year 3 will be 25-26 school year:

6-7-8 grades

North Middle School will open officially

Approximately: 750 students, 100 staff, 3 lunches, who knows how many buses

This year TrailRidge will become a 9th grade school building

PK – 5th grade Radiant, Walnut Hills and Waterford will feed into these schools

Typical day:

8:05 AM – day starts with Advisory

8 classes – 42 minutes each

Passing time – 4 minutes

Lunch 30 minutes

School day ends at 2:58 PM

Mr. Shockey shared about different activities, clubs and that school sponsored sports start in 8th grade.

Goals for year 1 were to provide a safe, supportive and orderly environment for the students and staff.
