Ateliers SP's New Works Debut at Révélations 2025

Ateliers SP unveiled its 2025 collection debut at Révélations, showcasing artisan mastery

This year, Ateliers SP unveiled its latest collection at Révélations 2025, held at the Grand Palais. The new works explore a blend of heritage, innovation, and artisan techniques, drawing on sculptural forms and a diverse range of materials. The collection aims to connect traditional craftsmanship with contemporary design, referencing both historical and modern influences.

The 2025 collection is a testament to the studio's philosophy: sublimating noble, ancestral materials through design that is both modern and rooted in tradition. On display are reinterpretations of classic forms—soft, round curves for lamps and stools, sharply defined angles for screens and puzzles—inviting viewers to question, admire, and interact with each unique piece. Materials are chosen not only for their beauty but for their potential to surprise, with some works impressing through monumental scale and others through delicate finesse. The result is a collection that draws the eye, challenges expectations of craftsmanship, and celebrates the singularity of each creation.

Highlights include a contemporary reinterpretation of the "Confident" (a double-seated armchair) combining rare straw marquetry and Russian leather with new horizontal inlay techniques and flexible, undulating screens. Two sculptural lights balance function and experimentation, pairing noble woods such as ziricote and guilloché ebony with traditional decorative methods to highlight the individuality of each piece. The collection also features a brain teaser puzzle crafted from polished ebony and accented with fish leather, notable for its refined design and tactile qualities. The Cascade table stands out for its rare application of straw marquetry on highly rounded curves, exemplifying the blend of ancestral craft and contemporary design. Completing the collection, a series of small boxes by Frédéric Hamel showcases expert turning, guilloché, and hand-carving on precious woods, metals, and mother-of-pearl, demonstrating mastery in both material selection and technique.

Ateliers SP's collection is the product of dedicated artisans who blend tradition with innovation, pushing the boundaries of contemporary craft. The debut of these new works at the Grand Palais is more than a showcase—it is a statement. The collection has drawn admiration for its technical mastery, bold design choices, and the invitation it extends to rediscover the possibilities of traditional materials. Collectors, critics, and design enthusiasts alike have praised the studio's ability to honor the past while forging a distinctly modern path, confirming Ateliers SP's place at the forefront of contemporary artisanal design.

Echoes of Tomorrow: How Music Shapes My Art

Marina Fedorova's June Hia column explores how music shapes emotion, memory, atmosphere, and vision in her art.

There are sounds that come from the future, and there are sounds that seem to have always existed—like whispers from another dimension. As a visual artist drawn to the poetic possibilities of science fiction and the elegance of classical forms, I live between those echoes. For me, music is not just background—it's a portal. It shapes the emotional architecture of my creative process, the way a melody carves space in silence, or how a single note can illuminate a world.

My love for music began, perhaps like many others, in childhood—with classical compositions that felt like fairy tales for the soul. But over time, this connection evolved into something more abstract, more expansive. Today, when I paint, I often find myself listening to Joe Hisaishi's scores—his music, especially for Studio Ghibli films, has the ability to touch both innocence

and longing. There's something inherently futuristic in its simplicity. It doesn't speak of machines, but of emotions that transcend time.

At the same time, I'm drawn to the sweeping emotional landscapes of opera. Edvard Grieg's Peer Gynt, with its Nordic melancholy and mythic grandeur, resonates with the kind of stories I tell on canvas—myths not of ancient gods, but of space travelers, of urban dreamers floating in their own private galaxies. His music has that rare quality: it carries both stillness and motion, like time unfolding slowly under a velvet sky.

Two artists from the past deeply resonate with this intersection between sound and vision. One is Wassily Kandinsky, who believed that painting could express music—that color had tone, and that shapes had rhythm. His abstract compositions feel like symphonies on canvas, vibrating with emotional energy. Kandinsky's work gives me permission to think beyond form, to treat painting as a sensorial experience that flows like music across time and space.

The other is Mikalojus Konstantinas Čiurlionis, the Lithuanian composer and painter who lived between worlds—musical and visual, real and dreamlike. His paintings often feel like visual scores, full of harmony and atmosphere. He didn't just illustrate music—he embodied it, channeling the soul of both art forms into unified poetic visions. In many ways, Čiurlionis reminds me that the artist is always a bridge—between senses, between eras, between realms.

In the world I imagine, art is not separate from music, or from architecture, or from dreams. They all form one orbiting system—like planets around the same sun.

Cosmodreams Project Continues with Chrysalis at Beijing Contemporary Art Fair

Marina Fedorova's Chrysalis bridged the physical and digital at ART021, using AR and fine art to explore feminine perspectives on change.

The ART021 Beijing Contemporary Art Fair concluded on May 25, 2025, having welcomed thousands of visitors over four days. One of the notable features of the event was the immersive solo exhibition Chrysalis by acclaimed Russian artist Marina Fedorova, presented by Sputnik Partners at Booth G01. The exhibition captivated audiences with its poetic exploration of transformation, nature, and technology through a distinctly feminine lens.

Drawing crowds from around the globe, including artists, collectors, curators, and media, Chrysalis created a dynamic and engaging environment that invited viewers not only to observe, but to participate. Marina Fedorova's integration of multiple media — including painting, sculpture, lenticular printing, and augmented reality — created a layered, interactive experience. Viewers were encouraged to use their smartphones to activate AR content embedded in the artworks, extending the narrative beyond the physical installation and deepening the emotional connection.

The exhibition transformed the booth into a contemplative, light-filled space, where stories of metamorphosis and inner growth unfolded. "I explore the moment of transition — the pause

between past and future, when everything holds still before a new ascent," Fedorova said, emphasizing her vision of technology as a means to reestablish harmony with nature rather than disrupt it.

One of the highlights of the fair was the roundtable discussion "Women Artists: Nature, Technology, and Cultural Synthesis," held on the opening day. Moderated by Xiao Ge, Editor-in-Chief of Phoenix Art, the forum featured Marina Fedorova alongside Peng Wei, a leading Chinese ink artist. The dialogue offered a compelling comparison of artistic approaches across cultures and generations, examining how female voices are shaping contemporary perspectives on nature and innovation.

Visitors to Chrysalis were deeply moved, describing the installation as "a soft digital world" and remarking that the works seemed to "breathe with the body." This positive reception reflects growing interest in immersive, sensory-driven art that bridges the physical and digital.

Chrysalis marked a significant contribution to ART021 Beijing's programming and underscored the global relevance of Russian contemporary art. As part of the ongoing Cosmodreams project, it reinforced Fedorova's commitment to addressing ecological, social, and philosophical themes through cutting-edge media and a nuanced, personal voice.

ART021 Beijing Forum Features Marina Fedorova in Cross-Cultural Art Dialogue

Marina Fedorova joins Peng Wei at ART021 Beijing to explore feminine views on ecology, technology, and artistic identity.

Beijing, May 25, 2025 — A thought-provoking roundtable titled "Women Artists: Nature, Technology, and Cultural Synthesis" took center stage at the opening of ART021 Beijing Contemporary Art Fair on May 22. The forum brought together prominent voices in contemporary art for a cross-cultural dialogue on how female artists are shaping the discourse around ecology, innovation, and identity in an increasingly interconnected world.

Held at the 798·751 Art District, the event featured Russian contemporary artist Marina Fedorova, renowned Chinese ink painter Peng Wei, and was moderated by Xiao Ge, Editor-in-Chief of Phoenix Art and Vice President of the Phoenix Center. The conversation explored how feminine perspectives are redefining the relationship between humans, nature, and digital technology.

Xiao Ge opened the discussion by highlighting how women artists often employ a decentralized, emotionally driven narrative style that emphasizes intuition and lived experience. She noted that such approaches challenge dominant structures and offer new pathways for understanding the human condition in the context of technological change.

Marina Fedorova, known for her immersive multimedia works, emphasized the role of new media as a sensory bridge rather than a barrier between humanity and the natural world. "Technology, when approached with sensitivity, can serve as a tool for reconnection," she said, referring to her current exhibition *Chrysalis*, which integrates painting, AR, and sculpture to reflect on transformation and inner renewal.

Peng Wei contributed a contrasting but complementary perspective grounded in traditional Chinese aesthetics. Through the lens of classical ink painting, she reflected on time, balance, and the symbiotic relationship between humans and nature, drawing parallels with Eastern philosophies of cyclical transformation.

Despite their differing artistic languages — one rooted in futurism and digital innovation, the other in classical techniques and cultural memory — both artists expressed a shared commitment to portraying nature as a source of strength, continuity, and emotional depth. Their dialogue underscored the expanding role of women artists in bridging ancient wisdom with contemporary challenges.

The forum concluded with a walk-through of Marina Fedorova's *Chrysalis* exhibition at the Sputnik Partners booth, where the conversation continued informally among guests and fellow artists. The session served not only as an exchange of ideas but as a live example of how art can act as a platform for global dialogue and cultural synthesis.

Cannes: Where Art Walks the Red Carpet

Marina Fedorova's May Hia column captures the magic of Cannes as a living canvas of cinema, style, and storytelling

As the glittering lights return to the Croisette this May 13–24, the 78th Cannes Film Festival is ready to dazzle once more. For me, as an artist, cinema has always been a profound source of inspiration. When watching films by directors like David Lynch, Wong Kar-Wai, and Takeshi Kitano, each frame feels like a living painting, pulsing with atmosphere, emotion, and artistic vision.

While fine art is a medium often reserved for connoisseurs, cinema is more democratic form of art for the broader audience, art that should be free, and above all, inspire.

Cannes was born from resistance. In 1946 it emerged from the rubble of war and censorship, determined to champion the freedom of artistic expression. Over the decades, it has welcomed bold voices, controversial visions, and emerging talents—refusing to let politics, commerce, or fear dilute the raw power of film.

This year that spirit feels more alive than ever.

Cannes isn't just about cinema—it's about spectacle. The iconic red carpet becomes a stage of elegance, eccentricity, and cinematic royalty. It's where legends meet their fans, new stars are born beneath the flash of cameras, and timeless style walks hand-in-hand with creativity.

The eyes of the world turn to Cannes, eagerly awaiting the premieres, the stars we adore, and the unforgettable stories yet to unfold.

From global icons like Tom Hanks, Scarlett Johansson, and Benedict Cumberbatch, to beloved indie figures and rising voices, the red carpet blurs the line between fantasy and reality.

This year, two films speak especially my heart.

Richard Linklater's Nouvelle Vague is a monochrome time machine to 1950s Paris, capturing the chaotic genius behind Jean-Luc Godard's revolutionary Breathless. Shot entirely in French and framed in black-and-white, it's a love letter to the birth of modern cinema and the creative rebellion that still echoes today.

In contrast, Wes Anderson's The Phoenician Scheme is a kaleidoscope of color and intrigue. A whimsical yet razor-sharp espionage tale, it's populated by an ensemble of Anderson regulars and fresh faces—from Benicio del Toro to Mia Threapleton. With its pastel precision, stylized storytelling, and philosophical undertones, it promises to charm, provoke, and delight.

There's something electric in the air at Cannes. That moment before the lights dim—when the world holds its breath in anticipation. Cannes is more than just a festival; it's a pilgrimage, a gathering place for dreamers, rebels, and storytellers who continue to believe in cinema's power to shape culture, evoke emotion, and reflect the spirit of our time.

Marina Fedorova shares concepts behind exhibition Cosmodreams: Elementa

Behind the exhibition talk with the artist opens up ideas, techniques and approach of Cosmodreams project

Cosmodreams is a pure fantasy, a futuristic vision that is difficult to define in one sentence. It is a multi-dimensional project combining traditional and digital art. The project incorporates classical art forms like painting and sculpture, blending them with modern digital technologies such as augmented reality, virtual reality, and video art.

The exhibition, curated by Sputnik Partners, highlights the importance of tradition and its evolution in modern life. Inspired by a pre-Islamic goddess of fertility, love, and nature, the exhibition reimagines this figure with a contemporary perspective, reflecting respect for cultural heritage while envisioning its place in the modern world.

Each presentation of the project adapts slightly to the traditions and mythology of the hosting region. For this exhibition, local fairy tales and mythology were incorporated into the artworks, creating a meaningful connection with the region's heritage. The exhibition's creative process was shaped over many years, influenced by humanity's fascination with the cosmos and the possibilities of space exploration.

The project also focuses on the elements of nature, emphasizing ecological concerns. Marianne Barrier joins Ateliers SP

Ateliers SP welcomes Marianne Barrier, an artisan in rye straw marquetry, blending 17th-century French craft with modern design innovation

Ateliers SP welcomes Marianne Barrier to its team of artisans. Specializing in rye straw marquetry, Marianne brings a fresh perspective to this 17th-century French craft, blending historical techniques with contemporary design. Her expertise is set to elevate Ateliers SP's commitment to merging artistry with craftsmanship in the world of collectible design and decorative arts.

Marianne Barrier's journey into the world of marquetry reflects a deep commitment to sustainability and a passion for material innovation. Her academic path began with preparatory studies in architecture and design, followed by a five-year program at the Beaux-Arts, where she earned a master's degree in design. Her thesis focused on transforming waste into alternative materials, particularly aiming to replace petrochemical plastics with sustainable solutions.

During her postgraduate research, Marianne explored materials derived from the agricultural industry, which led to her discovery of rye straw—a historically significant but underutilized material. Fascinated by its versatility and eco-friendly properties, she turned her attention to rye straw marquetry, an intricate craft that combines precision with artistic expression. She developed her skills at the Lison de Caunes workshops, where she trained intensively for nearly two years.

Marianne's creative process begins with conceptual sketches, followed by detailed plans or 3D models. Once the design is finalized, she collaborates with a cabinet maker to create the furniture base, typically using medium-density plywood. The rye straw, sourced from a producer in Burgundy, is then carefully applied to achieve the intricate inlay patterns. The final touch involves waxing and polishing to bring out the straw's natural luster. However, the process is not without challenges.

"Rye straw is subject to natural variations due to climate and weather conditions," Marianne notes. "Some years, the straw may be drier or more brittle, which increases waste and working time. Adapting to these variations requires both patience and creativity."

At Ateliers SP, Marianne aims to modernize marquetry while preserving its historical roots. Her work draws heavily from the Art Deco movement, a style that celebrates bold patterns and rich textures, while incorporating contemporary influences to meet modern design trends.

Marina Fedorova became mentor in Art + Tech Programme at Abu Dhabi Art 2024

The Art + Tech Programme showcased results at Abu Dhabi Art 2024 (November 20–24, Manarat Al Saadiyat). Guided by Marina Fedorova and Afra Al Suwaidi, students created works that reflected nostalgic childhood memories in both physical and digital forms.

Art + Tech is an annual community programme commissioned by the Department of Culture and Tourism – Abu Dhabi inviting artists to collaborate with Art and Technology

students in a series of workshops. The purpose of the program is to bridge the gap between Art + Technology in their studies.

Marina Fedorova, one of the two mentors in this year's Art + Tech Programme, has led a group of talented UAE students in creating an installation. Working with Marina provides students with a rare opportunity to gain practical skills and knowledge in the use of augmented reality in their creative work. The result of their collaboration was presented at Abu Dhabi Art 2024, showcasing the exciting intersection of art and technology.

Visitors of Abu Dhabi Art 2024 had the opportunity to interact with The Art + Tech Programme results at the Community Projects section.
