We live in the age of information': this sentence has become a commonplace of our times. Our everyday language includes the word 'information' in a variety of different contexts. It seems that we all precisely know what information is.

Data and information are the lifeblood of the 21st century economy. In the Information Age, data is recognized as a vital organisational asset. "Organizations that do not understand the overwhelming importance of managing data and information as tangible assets in the new economy will not survive."

Information is stimuli that have meaning for the recipient in some context. When data is collected and processed, it becomes information. When data is assembled or used to better understand or perform a task, it is transformed into knowledge in the form of information assets.

In the other word, Data that has been transformed into a more usable or understandable format is referred to as information. It is a collection of facts that has been structured for direct use by mankind, as information assists humans in making decisions. The data is assembled into a comprehensible form to retrieve the information. Students' grades and roll numbers, for example, are data, while the report card/sheet is information. It's worth noting that data may be further analysed and/or altered to provide knowledge.

The notion of data, information, and information assets will be explored in the context of academic quality and ranking, as well as decision-making in this session. The session participants will interact with the main components of well-formulated information assents, as well as their values for rating online effect. We'll show how a basic knowledge of the difference between data and valuable information assents may help everyone in our academic community. Furthermore, they will learn to;

- 4. Info in quality and development of our academic communities.
