



EDLTCC Use of Changing Rooms policy

EDLTCC strives to ensure that all children and adults are safeguarded from abuse and have an enjoyable experience.

This document sets out the EDLTCC policy for the acceptable use of our changing rooms.

1. Adults and children need to share our changing rooms except during tournaments when special arrangements may be made.
2. If adults or children feel uncomfortable sharing facilities, there is access to separate toilets (1 female and 1 male) and an accessible toilet.
3. Under no circumstances will adult staff, coaches or volunteers change or shower at the same time as children using the changing rooms.
4. If we are made aware that a child or adult self-identifies as a gender that differs from the gender they were assigned at birth, we will work with them and their parents/carers (where it relates to a child) to make reasonable adjustments to changing arrangements to suit their needs.
5. Mobile phones and other electronic devices must not be used in changing rooms.
6. For younger groups of children, a DBS checked member of staff or volunteer will wait outside the changing rooms to allow children to call for assistance if required.
