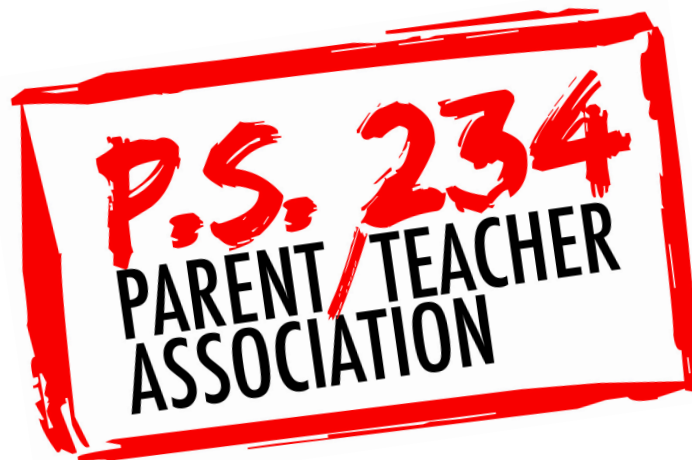

PTA Meeting Minutes - April 17th at 6pm via Zoom

1. PARENT COORDINATOR UPDATE

2. PTA REPORT

3. FINANCIAL REPORT

- Account Balance as of 4/17/24 is \$31,118.46
- Our current approved budget is \$51,000
- Current income: \$43,665
- Current expenses: \$34,286
- Have exceeded our goal of \$51,000
- Votes were called to increase the Fundraising Expenses and the Community Outreach/Gifts budget lines by \$1,000 each. Each passed. The new total budget is \$53,000
- A detailed explanation of what the money has been used for was given. Highlights include: a recess cart, Bricks 4 Kids 1 day program for grades K - 5, and Main Stages Assemblies for the whole school

4. PTA Fundraising/Events

- The Talent Show was on 3/8/24 with 18 acts. You can check out the video online
- The Read a Thon ended on Friday, 3/22. Over 184,000 minutes were read school-wide, with 394 students logging minutes. Total amount raised is \$6,819.75. The winners of the pizza and donut parties were announced, all parties will happen before the end of May.
