Can you help in your local community?

Location

Gibby Green Fingers is a volunteer led community allotment based in the heart of the Gibbonsdown community (next to Pencoedre Fields)

Time

Two hours a week, with possible seasonal variations. There is considerable time flexibility. Current volunteers visit the site three times a week on a Monday, Wednesday and Saturday.

Purpose

- To maintain and improve the community allotment and garden area which comprises of a summer house, raised beds, polytunnels, wildlife area and pond
- To work alongside other volunteers whilst also working independently in the community allotment with its upkeep

Duties include

- ☐ To assist with watering, weeding and planting as required
- ☐ To assist with mowing, strimming and cutting back of overgrowth
- ☐ To keep pathways clean and cleared of debris
- ☐ To liaise with volunteers on daily project work

Training required

- ☐ A basic knowledge of plant care and use of gardening tools
- ☐ Ability to work alongside other volunteers at the community allotment
- ☐ A good understanding of relevant health and safety issues

Supervisor

- ☐ The site supervisor (also a volunteer) is the main contact person for the volunteer. The supervisor will be responsible for the allocation of gardening tasks

Hours of Work

- ☐ 2-4 hours a week days to be agreed
- ☐ Full training and development opportunities would be provided
