

Student Support Team - 2026 Summer

(Previously Health & Safety)

The Lambert Marching Band needs parents to volunteer during summer camps to provide support for the students and the directors so they can stay focused on rehearsals and the show.

For Band camp we do not have full access to the LHS building, only the bandroom and stadium, so this is a modified version for the 2026 band camp.

Band Camp - July 20 - 24, 27th; 9am - 9pm

At Joint Venture Park/Daves Creek Elementary (140 students/2 Volunteers - Winds, Guard):

- For the July camp the band will be in two locations
- Students will have access to Daves Creek Elementary for bathrooms, sectionals, lunch, water refills, and storm shelter
- They will also be on the Joint Venture field and around the parking lots
- Access to bathrooms and water fountains also available at Joint Venture
- Stay close by for anything that comes up. Have first aid bags available if needed.
- Provide phone number in LMB Group/BandApp
- Emergency Contact phone number is in the front pocket of the bag if needed. This number should only be used if 911 is called or if student has a medical emergency.

Student Support Volunteers 1st Shift - 9am - 11am

- Go to the Cafeteria to fill water coolers. Take the big orange Gatorade cooler, the white metal cart and the black backpacks that are marked for Health and Safety. Make sure the cart has some plastic cups (extra cups will be provided). Students should have a large water jug for refillable purposes, but just in case.



- The black backpacks are the first aid bags and are either hanging on the white cart or stored on the shelves located in the cafeteria
- Fill the Water Jugs with ice and water and take to Joint Venture or wherever it is needed most. It might work out best if the cooler and the cart are loaded into a vehicle and driven over or just pushed carefully along the side walk.
- *NOTE: We cannot provide Gatorades or sugary drinks to the students while they are rehearsing. Just water. Gatorade bottles can be kept for emergency/overheating purposes.*



Volunteers throughout the day (2 hour shifts):

- The orange water coolers and Health and Safety Bags should now be outside where the band is practicing (Practice Field or Football Field).
- Check the schedule posted by Mr. Morrison or Dr. Buckholtz in the band app to know where they are located at the time of your arrival. **Post a comment on the BandApp - LMB 2026 group that you are there and include your phone number if they need anything.**
- You may need to assist in refilling the water coolers.
- At the end of the shift, please do the following:
 - Empty the orange cooler
 - Leave the cart back in the DCE cafeteria kitchen; leave it open with the lid of the cooler off. This allows the cooler to dry out.
 - Place the black backpacks (Health and Safety Backpacks) on the shelf. Please clean out any items and notify the E Board (via the Band App) if additional supplies are needed.
 - If the Cooling Cloths need to be washed, please volunteer to take them home, wash them and bring them back or notify the E Board (via the Band App)..

Health and Safety Backpacks

(These are for basic first aid; for any accidents or medication needs, directors need to handle; technically students are not allowed to receive over the counter medication without a medical note)

- Make sure the bags have:



- o A few Blue cooling towels
 - o Basic first aid (Band aids, neosporin, bug bite spray, disposable ice packs, ace bandages)
 - o Some granola bars and Gatorade in case a student needs a little bit of sugar
- Do your best to keep the bags organized so things are easy to find when needed.

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Band Camp - July 20 - 24, 27th; 9am - 9pm

At Lambert High School (30 students/1 volunteers - Percussion):

- Students will have limited access to LHS Bandroom, bathrooms, water refills, storm shelter, and lunch/dinner serve out.
- Battery will be around the stadium or bus loop and Pit will be in the band room
- Stay close by for anything that comes up. Have first aid bags available if needed.
- Cut fruit and snacks will be brought over from DCE by the Hospitality team for lunch (students bring their own lunch)
- Set up a table to manage any lunches that are dropped off by parents.
- Collect donations that are brought in (Snacks/fruit).
- Provide phone number in LMB Group/BandApp

Student Support Volunteers 1st Shift

- Fill water coolers with ice/water (location TBD; most likely at concession stand; use the “key” to turn on water. Leave the cooler, the white metal cart and the black backpacks that are marked for Health and Safety close to where battery will be (confirm if by stadium or by band room). Make sure the cart has some plastic cups in case students don’t have a large water jug.



- The black backpacks are the first aid bags and are either hanging on the white cart or stored with the cooler rack.
- *NOTE: We cannot provide Gatorades or sugary drinks to the students while they are rehearsing. Just water. Gatorade bottles can be kept for emergency/overheating purposes*

Volunteers throughout the day:

- The orange water coolers should be refilled as needed and Health and Safety Bags should be now outside where the band is practicing (Parking Lots or Football Field).
- Check the schedule posted by Mr. Morrison or Dr. Buckholtz in the band app to know where they are located at the time of your arrival. Post a comment on the BandApp - LMB 2026 group that you are there and include your phone number if they need anything.
- You may need to assist in refilling the water coolers. Coolers may need to be rolled to the stadium for later in the day. If by the stadium, we can use the concession stand for ice/water. Will need the key to turn on the water hose (see Adalecia Aleman; Mr. McCrea has the key to get into concession stand).
- At the end of the shift, please do the following:
 - o Empty the orange cooler
 - o Leave the cart back in the band room booster closet; leave the cooler open with the lid off. This allows the cooler to dry out.
 - o Place the black backpacks (Health and Safety Backpacks) on the white rack. Please clean out any items and notify the E Board (via the Band App) if additional supplies are needed.
 - o If the Cooling Cloths need to be washed, please volunteer to take them home, wash them and bring them back or notify the E Board (via the Band App).

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
