For many students, dual enrollment and/or college in the high school can be a powerful head start—a chance to tackle college-level rigors while still in high school. We are hopeful to award grants to students looking to engage in these opportunities. We also recognize that families navigating financial hardship, the "hidden costs" of these opportunities can feel like a barrier rather than a bridge.

Eligibility, Consideration & Financial Need

The bullets listed below will be considered as grants are awarded. To ensure these funds reach those who need them most, applicants who meet a demonstrated financial need on their application will be prioritized.

- **Demonstrated Need:** Assertion that there is financial assistance needed to make this dual enrollment opportunity a reality.
- **Academic Enrollment:** Approved for dual enrollment via Newport High School according to Board Policy.
- **Course Completion:** Must complete and pass the course(s). Students may be asked to reimburse the foundation for the grant amount in the event of a failed course.
- **Grant Award Amounts:** Number of grants and awarded amounts may vary based on applicants and funds available.

Process

1. Complete Dual Enrollment / CiHS Application with the Buffalo Foundation
2. Enroll in Dual Enrollment / CiHS classes via Newport High School
3. Provide proof of enrollment and a bill to: newportbuffalofoundation@gmail.com
4. Complete class with a passing grade
5. Passing grade will be confirmed with Newport High School

Grant Coverage

Tuition for dual enrollment / CiHS class(es). Grants may be awarded up to the full cost of tuition.
