Basics Terms

Cryptocurrency

a digital currency in which encryption techniques are used to regulate the generation of units of currency and verify the transfer of funds, operating independently of a central bank.

Bitcoin

Bitcoin is one of the first digital currencies created in 2009. It follows the ideas set out in a white paper by the mysterious Satoshi Nakamoto, whose true identity has yet to be verified. All the altcoins can be bought with BTC.

Altcoins

Altcoins are the alternative cryptocurrencies launched after the success of Bitcoin. Generally, they project themselves as better substitutes to Bitcoin.

Wallet

A Cryptocurrency wallet is a software program that stores private and public keys and interacts with various blockchains. In simple words it's a way to interact with crypto currencies that you own.

First steps: Where to buy coins?

There are several places that let you buy cryptocurrencies with your currency.

Coinbase

The easiest place to buy, use, and accept bitcoin, ethereum, and litecoin. That should be your first step to purchase a bitcoin.

Exchanges

Exchanges are used to buy and sell coins.

GDAX

Pros:

- user friendly, clear interface
- it's insured! <https://www.coinbase.com/legal/insurance>
- Cons:
- Not too many choices of coins just BTC, ETH and LTC
- No lending markets

Poloniex

Pros:

- Big exchange with a lot of coins
- Lending market

Cons:

- Not insured

- Slow under big traffic - that tends to affect all of the exchanges though
- User interface reminds me beginnings of WWW sites

Bittrex

Place where the coins start before they get to Poloniex.

Pros and cons are the same as Poloniex.

Other ones

There are bunch of other ones I had a chance to try like Yobit, Cryptopia, and Bitfinex, they are focused on coins with smaller volume.
