NOTE- EDUCATION AND NURSING HAVE SPECIFIC APPLICATION FORMS

- Application cost is \$100 (Check the UofR website for Admission on the spot dates to pay a reduced fee)
- You will be required to submit official high school transcripts as part of the application process.
- Request Transcripts to be submitted from the Ministry of Education to the University

3. **Wait for your admissions letter.** If accepted, you will receive a letter of offer in the mail, outlining your admission to the University of Regina. You can check the progress of your application by logging into your application account.
4. **Confirm Acceptance of your offer.** Your letter of offer will outline how to confirm acceptance of the offer of admission. (If you're not sure, or are waiting for responses from other Universities, it's a good idea to accept your offer early. You are not locked into a commitment; you may still change your mind if you decide to go elsewhere. Just contact our admissions office and let us know of the change.)
5. **Watch for a Welcome Letter from your Faculty.** This will contain contact information and next steps before you register for classes.
6. **Book your Academic Advising Session.** Most faculties ask that you meet with an advisor, either individually or as a group to provide you with IMPORTANT information about the University, your program and registration.
7. **Register for classes!** Following your Academic Advising Session, you will be able to choose your courses and register for the classes you will be taking during your first semester.

Important University of Regina Dates:

- Priority Application Deadline (qualifies you for entrance scholarships) March 15
- Faculty of Education Deadline- March 1
- Faculty of Nursing Deadline- February 15 (separate application form)
- Final official high school transcripts must be submitted to the Admissions Office by August 1
