AGLC Property Committee Minutes 8/5/2024

Old Business

Christine suggested carpeting and padding for the office stair.

Christine has requested a quote, Per Pastor Nick, the carpeting will be included with renovations gifted by a member

Hire lawn and/or garden maintenance. Grounds care expenses are included in the 2024-2025 budget submitted. Ray suggested Bowman Landscaping begin tending the gardens. Craig requested a quote for non-lawn services and Bowman did not want to bid if lawn is excluded. Guy will seek a similar quote

Lights for the cross in front of the Church: Christine requested a quote to add light to the South side of the cross. Daniel Electric will be out to provide a quote on 8/13/24.

Youth building porch cover: The project is complete, except a torn section of siding available at Home Depot for \$8.45 for a 24" section.

Repair of 3 pole lights. Tony Seris contacted the vendor for a quote and \$1,300 was quoted. All 5 poles now need repair of 1 or 2 lighting units. Paul will follow-up with Tony.

The exterior light on the Fellowship room door has a loose connection. Tim and Mike are addressing.

Gravel to fill the East side of the turnaround. Gravel is in place and graded. We still found pooling water after the July rainstorm. We will monitor and add Gravel or drainage as required

Doors on the South side of buildings require maintenance and painting. Guy and Paul will address repairs when weather cools.

Proposal for Sanctuary lighting and control panel. Alan did not receive a clear cut response when he asked the Council whether they wanted us to proceed. He will ask Jonathan for guidance on presenting the request to the Council.

Bare wires on the middle AC unit, West side of the Sanctuary. Craig covered the wires with liquid tape.

New Business

Kim Haggerty has requested help moving furniture stored for GRACE housing from the Education building to a new location. She is planning a workday on August 10, 2024 and asked for volunteers. Call Kim to volunteer.

Carol Court asked whether a swing could be installed in the Sensory room. Alan will discuss requirements and options with Carol.

Members Helping Seniors at AGLC. Paul is the contact for Property. Ray will follow up with Member Care to determine what part Property can play beyond identifying volunteers. Ray will ask the Pastor what, to his knowledge, support seniors need.
