## Non-Member Public Usage (\$35.00)

This single usage rate allows a person to utilize the range for one hour during open range hours. Visitors utilizing the range under this privilege must utilize ammunition purchased from *Family Traditions Gun Range, LLC*. If a person desires to bring in ammunition from an outside source a \$10.00 insurance surcharge will apply. Ear & Eye protection provided.

## Non-Member Public Usage Card (\$150.00)

This usage card allows a person to utilize the range 5 times within a year for one day period during open range hours. Members utilizing the range under this package must utilize ammunition purchased from *Family Traditions Gun Range, LLC*. If a card holder desires to bring in ammunition from an outside source a \$10.00 insurance surcharge will apply. Ear & Eye protection provided.

## Annual Membership (\$350.00)

This package allows a person to utilize the range unlimited for one year during all range hours. Members also receive a discounted rate on bulk ammo & FFL transfers. Members utilizing the range under this package may bring up to 5 guests during the duration of their membership. This package also allows members to bring their minor children without any additional cost. A member may add a spouse to their membership for an additional \$100.00. Ear & Eye protection provided.

**All instructional courses are scheduled on an appointment basis. Pre-registration is required. All applicants who are applying for any instructional course must complete the required registration process. All registrants must pay in full at the time of registration. Registrants are required to arrive 10 minutes prior to their appointment. Rescheduling must be done two business days prior to the appointment date. A rescheduling fee of \$15 will be applied. Deposits are not refundable. Targets, eye protection, & ear protection are provided for all instructional courses. Open toed shoes & low-cut shirts are prohibited. ### **Available Courses**

Cleaning & Maintenance of a Handgun or Shotgun {1 hour} (\$50)

Practical Home Defense or Situational Awareness Seminar {1 hour} (\$50)

1 on 1 Personal Coaching Session with a Handgun or Shotgun {1 hour} (\$75)

Basic Personal &/or Home Defense of a Handgun or Shotgun {1 hour} (\$75)

Basic Safety & Operation of a Handgun or Shotgun {2 hour} (\$75)

Tactical Defense Training Program {four 2-Hour Sessions} (\$200)

North Carolina Concealed Handgun Certification {8 hour} (\$100)

This eight-hour course is required to be completed prior to applying for a North Carolina conceal carry handgun permit. During this course the student will be responsible for demonstrating safe handling of the handgun and ability to load and unload the handgun. Also, the student will be required to demonstrate 80% proficiency or better with a handgun. A 30-round course of fire will be given. The student will fire 10 rounds at 3 yards, 10 rounds at 5 yards, 10 rounds at 7 yards at a b-27 target. Students will also be instructed & tested on basic parts of handguns and laws that govern the North Carolina concealed carry handgun permit. Upon completion of the course, you will receive a certificate of completion needed to obtain the North Carolina concealed carry permit. Family Traditions Gun Range, LLC requires all registrants to have a safe working knowledge of the handgun being utilized for

testing purposes. We strongly recommend enrolling in a basic course prior to registration if you do not have safe working firearm knowledge.
