

Vocabulary Study Buddy All Subjects, Grades K-12

Assignment Objectives

- Students will build a better understanding of the vocabulary terms associated with their current lesson.
- Students will use the Live Help feature to complete this activity.

Teacher Instructions

- Assign a vocabulary list to your students can be your own or a set of terms associated with the curriculum.
- Ask students to log on to Paper and start a Live Help session with a tutor.
- Have students send their vocabulary list, along with their definitions, to the tutor and ask them to send either the terms or definitions back to the student one at a time
- After working through the list, the tutor should then send sentences with missing vocabulary words so the student can fill it in with the correct word.
- The student will respond with either the term or definition, depending on which was sent to them, and will fill out their sheet as they go.
- As they match the terms and definitions, the students will also create a sentence that uses the vocabulary word correctly.

Ideas for Use

- Study aid for a text, quiz, or exam
- Introduction activity to new content
- Station or center for topic/content review

Example:

Word: Helium

Definition/Meaning: a Chemical element with the symbol He and atomic number 2.

Sentence: <u>Helium</u> is the second most abundant element in the universe, and the second lightest element

Student Instructions

- 1. Start a Live Help session with a tutor and send them your list of vocabulary words or terms with the definitions. Use Camera in the Classroom to send a photograph of this worksheet so the tutor knows what you will be working on.
- 2. Fill out the boxes below with the words or terms from your list only, placing one word or term in each box.
- 3. Ask your tutor to send you definitions or clues so that you can guess the word or term they are describing OR Ask your tutor to send you the words or terms and respond with the meaning or definition you believe matches.
- 4. As you correctly match the terms with their meanings, write them below the word.
- 5. After you have finished the list, ask your tutor to send you sentences with missing words. You will fill in the missing space with the correct vocabulary word and write the sentence in the coordinating box.
- 6. Once you have completed all of the terms from the list, hand this sheet in to your teacher.
