
# User Stories and Flows

## Homepage:

Epic 1.2: I want to know my progress from my actions so far so I know how I'm doing


Story 1.2.1: As an EH user, I want a concise landing page so I can explore all parts of the app and be **easily directly to selected areas**

Acceptance Criteria 1.2.1: Given that I am opening the EH app, when I arrive at the home page, I can immediately get an overview of the app's features/capabilities



Story 1.2.3: As an EH user, I want to understand **what my current EH points and levels mean** so that I could know where I'm in the Earth Points leader board (Levels Journey) and feel motivated to collect more points.

Acceptance Criteria 1.2.3: Given that I am opening the EH app, when I arrive at the home page, then the total number of EH points I've accumulated will be displayed in the page header along with the option to learn more about its breakdown



**Story 1.2.4: As an EH user, I want to see facts about climate change and EH's worldwide impact so that I can feel urgency and motivation to take action**

**Acceptance Criteria 1.2.4:** Given that I am opening the EH app, when I arrive at the home page, then facts about climate change will be displayed in the page header along with my total EH points and EH's worldwide impact will be in a module.



**Story 1.2.5: As an EH user, I want to be directed to update emission on the home page so I can keep my information up to date while also understanding how emissions is calculated.**



### EPIC:


I want to view and edit app-related and account info just in one place so I won't feel confused where to find what.

As an EH user, I want to know **where I can update app-related settings and account settings** quickly so that it doesn't take me long to change a small thing.


Acceptance Criteria: Given that I open EH app when I tap on the profile section, a module will be there to let me view,edit and delete my personal information and app information.

As an EH user, I want to know **how to connect with EH Team** so that I can contact with the EH team if I need to ask questions or send feedback.


Acceptance Criteria: Given that I open EH app when I tap on the profile section, a module will be there to let me contact with EH Team to give feedback, get support or ask questions.


I want to view my progress over time so I can see the impact I've made



As a user, I want to see if I have been **increasing or decreasing my pollution**, so that I can better understand the results of my actions.


Acceptance Criteria: Given that I am looking at 'My Emission over time' graph, I want to see the exact changes that happened after I completed an action.

As a user, I want to see how **my actions** are helping me reach my **Emission Target**, so that I can continue to be motivated.


Acceptance Criteria: Given that I select the option to change my emission target, I want to see how much impact an action can do and how many more actions I have to do to meet my target.

Acceptance Criteria: Given that I go to edit my emission target, I want to be able to easily input the estimates at any time.






Story 4.1.1: As a user browsing possible actions to add, I want to **store/save actions** that are not in progress to keep track of future actions that interest me.


Story 4.1.2: As a user viewing my action list, I want to **view my actions in progress** so that I can remain motivated to continue taking action against CC.


**Story 4.1.3: As a user viewing my action list page, I want to view my **completed actions** so that I can know my accomplishments against CC.**


**Story 4.1.4: As a EH user, I want to get **recommended actions to take** based on my preferences so that it is easier to select the next action to take.**




**Story 4.1.5: As a EH user, I want a **visual depiction of my completed actions** so that I can assess my accomplishments faster and effectiveness of my actions**



## Defined Usability Test Metrics

Task ease rating 1-5	
1 Very hard

## Results of Usability Test:

60% of the participants rated the tasks as easy (> 4.0) overall.

3 out of 8 of the tasks are rated as easy (> 4.0) by all participants.

New users ease of use average		3.8
Existing users ease of use average		4.2

## KPI(What does success look like?):

Long term:

- After product launch, we expect an increase in new user retention rate, which averages 46% over six weeks after the first usage.
- Increase the average number of actions achieved per user.
