I wish to bring greetings to the Class of 2026 families of Marshfield High School. Our community is committed to our mission of pursuing excellence in academics and achievement in all that we do. Students should arrive on their assigned date at 8:50 AM at the main entrance of the high school. Our meetings will begin at 9:00 AM and you can plan to pick up your student at 10:00 AM. Homeroom assignments will be included on your schedule that will be available on ASPEN on August 12 in the afternoon.

Digital learning is part of our school culture at Marshfield High School, and the chromebook distributed to your student will be used for their next four years of learning. Chromebook sign up information and access to the 1-1 technology portal will be sent on August 4. Every student/parent must access the portal, electronically sign the 1-1 User Agreement and select/pay online for a technology protection plan prior to your student's homeroom meeting date. **Individuals who have not completed this process will not receive their chromebook at their homeroom meeting.** Anyone who is away on vacation the week of August 16 should complete the chromebook sign up process and they can pick up their chromebooks the week of August 22, 2022. A building tour will be available on August 25th at 10:00 AM for any student unable to attend.

On August 25, 2022 we will be hosting Freshman Parent Orientation from 6:00 PM – 7:30 PM in our MHS Auditorium. You are welcome to bring your student with you to this introduction. The presentation will focus on the academic and social expectations of our high school. We hope parents will join us for this important evening.

Finally, August 30, 2022, we will host our Freshmen Orientation Day at Marshfield High School. The day will include providing our students a chance to meet all of their teachers, become comfortable in the building and to begin to understand how their high school works.

We look forward to meeting the Class of 2026 in the coming weeks.

On **August 2, 2022** the ASPEN portal will be available to start 1-1 registration for the upcoming school year. **This process needs to be completed for EACH student.** Parents will need to log-in to the Family Portal section of ASPEN at <https://aspen.mpsd.org>. Students cannot register through their Student Portal accounts. If you are unable to access the Family Portal, please contact aspen@mpsd.org for assistance. Any questions regarding registration should be directed to the main office at Marshfield High School.

1. All students/parents will be expected to sign our 1-1 User Agreement electronically.
2. All students/parents are advised to secure our technology protection plan for the duration of your student use at Marshfield High School. Payment will be made prior to distribution of your student device using our online payment process. Please see the Technology Plan and Procedures for cost and applied protection. Failure to secure protection will require you to individually pay for any repairs or replacement of the device, and is not recommended.
