From the Desk of the Secretary of State:

Dear Hassan Rouhani, President of Iran,

As you know, the United States has decided to pull out of the JCPOA that the previous administration reentered with your state, along with others across the world. President Rouhani, I'm for certain that, just like us, you don't like to be lied to. Based on this sentiment, The United States of America has decided to withdraw from this agreement. We could no longer trust you to uphold your end of the deal. The United States has obtained intelligence that detail numerous violations of the JCPOA by Iran. This is intended to be a clear message to Iran that further violations will not be tolerated. The United States will be looking to put back its sanctions on numerous Iranian sectors such as banking and oil, among other things. We encourage other member states to follow suit as a collective response to this display of dishonesty. Before we begin reimplementation of sanctions, we would be open to crafting a new deal which would seek a renegotiation between all member nations of JCPOA, current and former. This will be the last and final chance Iran has to reach a deal with the United States and others who have

grievances with Iran. Your regime has until the new year to respond with how they will proceed, because once January 1st rolls around, all chances of a deal are done and over. We are done taking this lightly and hope that you and your regime will see that it is in the best interests of everyone to reach a new deal that will be followed and respected. I look forward to your response, Mr. Rouhani, and hope we can reach some sort of new agreement which will restore trust between our two states.
