

## Performance Division

### Show Cards:

- Every entry MUST have a completed show card on the judges table with the model.
- 3"x5" index card or similar
- Face up side: Class number, breed, what the setup is depicting, and Horses name (for NAN you can only have 1 horse listed on the NAN card - this is the horse name we need on the show card)
- Back side: Your Show Id  
E.G.

### Documentation:

- Not required but suggested
- Limited to a single sheet of paper no larger than 8.5"x11".
- Books, phones, and tablets may not be used
- No references to the artist, tack maker, prop maker, or owner
- Describe what the horse is required to do and details about the scene itself. E.G. type of tack or specific gait/maneuver (if not obvious)

### Limitations:

- Your ticket covers up to 3 models (or setups) per class. Additional entries are \$1 each.
- A model may be shown in one section (all classes within that section) + 1 class each out of the other 2 sections as the judged model (listed on your show card - and please only list ONE horse even if there are multiples in your setup).
- A model may be used as a secondary model in as many setups as you want.
- Size limitations - (following Nan rules)
  - 18" x 30" maximum area for most setups
  - 24" x 30" maximum for Over Fences and Stock Work classes
  - More than 2 horse hitches can exceed the size restrictions without penalty
- Photo backdrops are not allowed
- These models can be shown in other divisions (Fun, Animals, Halter Breed, Collectability, or Workmanship)

### Specific Class Rules:

- In-hand setups will go into Other Performance (205)
- Western Pleasure (209) - No Setups - meaning no footing or props of any kind. The model should consist only the model, tack, and rider (optional)
- All other classes - setups are allowed.

### Set up Time:

- There will be 10 minutes of setup time for each class unless it becomes clear there are no entries. The timer starts when the class is called.
- Classes will not be held for late entries, multiple entries, or tack changes

### Judging Criteria:

- Model will judged on accuracy, conformation, biomechanics, breed suitability, and condition
- Tack fit and suitability
- Props are appropriate for the scene and scaled correctly
- Documentation is accurate
- Overall setup is cohesive and right for the class it is entered into.
- Judge's overall impressions
- Judging for Section and Division titles will be based on the "best of" and not on a point system or most won.

**Awards:**

- Classes are judged based on the above criteria.
- Section Champions & Reserve are chosen from the 1st and 2nd place winners in each class of that section
- Division Champion & Reserve are chosen from the Section Champions
- Best in Show is a peer chosen award from all of the Division Champions of that day.

***The judge has the authority to split, merge, or cancel classes as they see fit.***

***The judge's decisions are final.***
