Members will be elected by a vote of <u>all</u> parents and legal guardians of a student enrolled at the local school precinct. Your input is important to the success of our school and students. Vote



Should we receive nominations, elections will take place on Wednesday, September 18, 2024, via online Google Form.

Results of the SOT parent member election will be announced by email on Friday, September 20, 2024.

Attend Monthly Meetings

The principal will send out meeting information at least three days in advance. All meetings will include a time for public comment, and we encourage all parents to attend.



What is the role of the School Organizational Team?

- Provide input on the school performance plan and budget.
- Provide continued advice to the principal in carrying out the school plan.
- Assist with the selection of the next principal when there is a vacancy.

What are the requirements of Team members?

- Serve on the team through September 30, 2025, unless your child no longer attends the school.
- Attend meetings at least once per month, outside of school hours.
- Make decisions with the whole school population in mind.
- Work collaboratively and attempt to reach consensus with the team.

An organizational team and its members who are not employees of the large school district are immune from liability for civil damages as a result of an act or omission in performing any of the duties of the organizational team as set forth in sections 24 to 29, inclusive, of AB469
