FOND DU LAC — Roger L. Sharratt, 70, Route 3, Fond du Lac, died Wednesday evening in St. Agnes Hospital.

He was born Dec. 6, 1914, in Fond du Lac, the son of Lawrence B. and Ubena Candlish Sharratt. He married Gertrude M. Markert, Aug. 31, 1936. She is deceased. He married Barbara E. Halle July 26, 1975.
