1. Admin updates:

Daniel: thank you PAC for inviting us as part of the meeting. this September we will be having two French immersion Kindergartens, one late French immersion class(grade 6) and one English Kindergarten. And we also set up the invitation for “Welcome to Kindergarten” on May 31st(Weds). Next week, we will have early dismissal for “meet with the teacher” to discuss the progress of your children(on April 19th and 20th, school will finish at 2pm). Recently we also have some extra activities going on, we have several field trip to Vancouver Symphony Orchestra and we thank you all the parent volunteers who accompany our students on the field trip. We also have Trafalgar circles for students on April 21st and hand drumming workshop for students on April 28th.

Erin: We just finished our two weeks gymnastics programs and each student have participate in the class at least three times with the teacher. We have great feedback from students and staff. And this term we try to add a new sport(badminton) coached by one of the Kindergarten parents.

Right now we practice every Thursday morning and have games after school on Thursdays. And the team practice only take place in April but we hope that can be continued next April because it's very

popular among students. We also would like to thanks Snow as a co-coach volunteer for this team. We will also have track and field team coming in May and June for grade 4-7 students. And some of the lunchtime activities have been resumed which has been highlighted in the newsletter(green club, knitting club etc). And we also will have end of the year performance coming up and the band will perform on June 12th(the choir's performance date is not confirmed yet).
