

JUNIOR YEAR COURSE SELECTION INSTRUCTIONS

*** REGISTER FOR 35 CREDITS – STUDY HALL WILL BE ADDED BY YOUR COUNSELOR**

***REQUIRED COURSES:** English 11 (AP, Honors, CP) **AND** Health/PE

***SELECT AN ADDITIONAL 25 CREDITS MADE UP OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONAL SUBJECTS**

Social Studies, Math, Science, World Language, Career Exploration, Visual & Performing Arts

*** WHEN REQUESTING ELECTIVE COURSES IN SOCIAL STUDIES, CAREER EXPLORATION AND VISUAL PERFORMING ARTS, YOU MUST ALSO REQUEST A BACK UP OR ALTERNATE COURSE.**

FOR EXAMPLE, IF YOU WISH TO TAKE SOCIOLOGY AND CERAMICS, YOU MUST REQUEST EITHER TWO MORE 2.5 CREDIT COURSES OR ONE 5 CREDIT COURSE AS AN ALTERNATIVE. YOU CAN PICK THEM FROM ANY SUBJECT AREA, BACK UP COURSES DON'T HAVE TO BE THE SAME SUBJECT AS YOUR FIRST CHOICE (FOR EXAMPLE, TO BACK UP SOCIOLOGY YOU COULD CHOOSE GAME DESIGN). YOU'LL RANK THEIR PRIORITY FROM 1-4 IN THE DROP DOWN MENU NEXT TO THE COURSE. THIS MEANS THAT YOU MAY END UP REQUESTING UP TO 45 CREDITS, THAT'S OK, YOUR COUNSELOR WILL DISCUSS YOUR OPTIONS WHEN YOU MEET. IF THIS IS NOT DONE, YOUR COUNSELOR MAY HAVE TO CHOOSE AN ELECTIVE FOR YOU BASED ON AVAILABILITY – MAKE SURE THIS DOESN'T HAVE TO HAPPEN, CHOOSE THEM NOW

***IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING COURSE PLACEMENT**

- FOR NOW, COURSE REQUESTS WILL BE BASED ON YOUR SEMESTER 1 GRADES WITH THE EXCLUSION OF MATH. MATH TEACHER WILL MEET WITH THEIR STUDENTS IN APRIL TO INPUT THEIR MATH COURSE REQUESTS.

- IF YOU WISH TO TAKE A COURSE THAT YOU CURRENTLY DO NOT MEET THE PREREQUISITE, REQUEST THE COURSE YOU QUALIFY FOR NOW. WHEN YOU MEET WITH YOUR COUNSELOR, TELL HIM/HER WHICH COURSE YOU WOULD LIKE AND IF YOU QUALIFY TO WAIVE INTO THE COURSE YOUR COUNSELOR WILL ADVISE YOU HOW TO OBTAIN A WAIVER FORM.
