Introduction

1. Greeting & Introduction:

4. Task 4: Reading Testimonials

 "Please navigate to the testimonials section and browse through the reviews. Tell me your impressions and how easy it is to view multiple reviews."

5. Task 5: Contacting INGLU

"If you wanted to contact INGLU for more information, how would you do that?
 Please navigate to the contact section and describe the steps you would take."

Post-Test Questions

1. General Feedback:

 "What are your overall impressions of the wireframes? Were there any parts that you found particularly confusing or difficult to use?"

2. Specific Feedback:

- "What did you think about the layout of the internship section? Was it easy to find the information you were looking for?"
- "How did you find the event information layout? Was it clear and informative?"
- "Were the testimonials displayed in a way that made sense to you?"
- "Was the contact section easy to locate and understand?"

3. Suggestions for Improvement:

 "Do you have any suggestions for improving the design or making it more user-friendly?"
