### **BAO Grading Policy**

Grading periods

Semester One: 1st Grading per. ends 10/28, 2nd Grading per. ends 1/27 Semester Two: 3rd Grading per. ends 3/31, 4th Grading per. ends 6/9

#### Your grade is earned as follows:

#### 30% Daily Class Participation

4 points per day for the following:

- sign in daily
- in your seat, with instrument, music and pencil out by 7:23/8:26
- prepared for rehearsal (music practiced)
- personal best during rehearsal
- early is on time, on time is late
- Absence policy: school absences must be excused in the attendance office. Unexcused absences? Lose all of
  your points for that day.
- Tardy policy: Tardy? Lose one point for that day. (If the tardy sheet is up, sign it, you are tardy)

#### 10% Games (for Concert Band)

- Pep Band performs at selected football games and basketball games.
- Missed games must be excused in advance and made up with sectional

### 30% Service Projects (earn 3 service projects per grading period)

- 3 Projects earned=A, 2 Projects=B, 1 Project =C, 0 Project =F
- A BAO service project is a community service that every BAO member earns that contributes to the health of our groups.
- The following Service Projects count for all of a BAO member's SP grade in a grading period: Library Crew, Poster & Program Crew, Stage Crew, Daily Chairs & Stands Crew, Attendance Czar, I.T. Czar, Section Leader. If you would like to be considered for one of these jobs, please communicate with md or klw.
- Other Service Projects can be earned by doing stuff like:
  - O Turning in paperwork on time, 0 Absences/0 Tardies, Learn a new instrument\_Mentor in the UCB Music Connection, Join and participate in Tri-M Society (Begin Club), etc.

#### 30% Performance Participation

- Attend all required rehearsals and performances
- Absences are only excused IN ADVANCE in the event of extreme emergency: serious illness or
  hospitalization, death in the family, religious holiday or other reasons deemed excusable by the music
  directors. Comparable makeup work must be agreed to ahead of time and completed in agreed upon time.
- Dress for concerts is formal:

  - ★ Black dress socks and shoes (no sneakers or sandals)
  - ★ Tie for gentlemen (and any women who would like to wear a tie).
