

V; main - Current to the show, Daryl is with the Reapers trying to help Maggie and the others get into the food stores they're currently guarding. Daryl is unsure of how to keep

V; The trials - Daryl and Merle are on their way to Atlanta when the outbreak starts, leaving the two of them stranded outside with a new group of survivors.

V; the atlanta camp - set after Daryl and Merle's arrival in the atlanta camp. Daryl largely spends his time out hunting or on the outskirts of camp, not quite used to being part of a group

V; the farm - Set during season 2, the group is on the Greene Family Farm looking for Sophia and waiting for Carl to recover from his gunshot wound

V; the prison - Seasons 3- 4a, the group is holed up at the prison, first worrying about the governor and then the flu that is ravaging their numbers.

- SV; The Prison survives - Au where the Governor is killed and the group is able to establish the prison as a safe place to continue living.

V; Used to things being bad - Season 4b, Daryl is on the run with Beth, when she's kidnapped and he joins the group that eventually finds Carl, Rick, and Michonne.

V; we're goin' down - season 5, following the disaster at terminus the group is yet again on the run, they come across father Gabriel and his church and then Daryl and Carol head to Atlanta to find Beth. Following Beth's death the group keeps pushing North with Abraham, Eugene, and Rosita, despite there not being a cure or much hope.

V; Alexandria - season 6, After arriving at Alexandria Daryl starts going on runs for supplies with Aaron. For the most part he feels largely out of place in the very domestic atmosphere given off by the residents. He doesn't particularly like any of them but gets on well with Aaron and his husband, Eric as they share a mutual appreciation for motorcycles.

V; thus always to tyrants - Season 7 and 8. Rick has gotten the group involved in a brutal war with the saviors.

- Sv; no sanctuary - Daryl is being held prisoner at the sanctuary where he's tortured and humiliated by Dwight and Negan

V; sic semper tyrannis - Season 9 a, Daryl is forced to live at the sanctuary as its leader, trying to keep a strong hand on the surviving saviors despite considering them a lost cause. While doing his best to keep everything moving, nothing grows at the sanctuary and the people are unruly and awful. Daryl prompts Rick to allow him to leave but Rick won't allow it.

V; beggar in the morning - Set during the first four of the seven years Daryl lives in his woods camp by the river. The guilt over Rick's death and not being able to find a body to bring Michonne and the kids closure keeps him in his camp. The camp is closest to Alexandria, allowing him frequent visits to Judith and RJ

V; dear fellow traveler - set during the time Daryl and Leah live together in the cabin in the woods. Unlike years previous Daryl doesn't make nearly as frequent trips back to Alexandria or Hilltop. He instead spends the vast majority of his time in the woods with Leah or out searching for Rick.

V; the babysitter - Season 9b, Daryl is convinced to return to civilization by Carol in order to keep an eye on Henry while he's at Hilltop - something that proves more challenging than he'd initially anticipated.

V; still remembering - Season 10a, Daryl is doing his best to keep Carol alive and present following the death of her son while facing the ever growing threat of Alpha and the Whisperers.

V; or forgetting - Season 10b, Daryl is left to care for Judith and RJ as Michonne goes off to search for Rick and the tension between the whisperers comes to a head.

V; can you tell me what hurts more? - Season 10c, Daryl begins to isolate himself from Carol and pull away as they try to rebuild what remains of Alexandria and Maggie returns. He finally begins to face the reality of this new life after the war.

V; reap what i sow - 11a, in a desperate search for food daryl and a small group of others head out into DC to search for food. While there Daryl gets separated from the others and comes across Leah and her group, the Reapers.

V; the barkeep - Daryl owns a small bar in Atlanta, he lives in an apartment above it and is struggling to keep the bar afloat but it's good work that he loves. All sorts come in from bikers, to country singers, and even the occasional friend.
