50s 2nd XI Team Objectives.

60s 2nd XI Team Objectives:

- 1. Provide full support to the 1sts across the season and ensure that 2's players are equipped, ready and motivated to step up into the 1st XI whenever required
- 2. To be competitive in every match we play and go as far as we can in whichever knock-out level we progress to after the group stages
- 3. Ensure that everyone who represents Gloucestershire 60 2's feels welcome, included, gives of their best and enjoys the experience

70s 1st XI Team Objectives:

- 1. To qualify for the knock-out stages and try to retain the trophy
- 2. To incorporate new players into the team where possible whilst still maintaining a high standard of play
- 3. To liaise with 60s 3rd and 4th team captains to help non selected over 70's to get a game
