Themes of Success:

- ❖ Having a multidisciplinary team who meets regularly to plan school wide supports for engaging students and families and problem solves individual students who are not connecting.
- ❖ Regular input from general education teachers regarding students of concern/ level of engagement - *Resources:* [Student Referral Form](#), [Student Engagement Survey](#)
- ❖ Using data to differentiate levels of engagement and problem solving the students with the least connection first - *Resource:* [Engagement: Define it. Track it. Improve it](#)
- ❖ Identifying one point person for a student or family to limit overwhelming family with communication, and consider ways to streamline or reduce “auto-messages” such as from Canvas or attendance.
